Resolution Rejecting All Bids And Authorizing The City Administrator To Award A Negotiated Construction Contract To Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc. For The Bushrod Park Streetscape Improvements (Project No. B00520) For An Amount Not To Exceed Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000.00)

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared for Council to authorize rejection of all bids and negotiation of a contract and award to Beliveau Engineering in the amount of \$330,000.00 for the Bushrod Park Streetscape Improvement Project. The project is located in Council District One.

Beliveau Engineering is the most responsible bidder and has met all the contract requirements. Funds are available for the contract work. This project is consistent with the Mayor and City Council Goal to Improve Oakland's Neighborhoods and to Maintain and Enhance Oakland's Physical Assets.

The project will construct an eight-foot wide entry stair into Bushrod Park, add eighteen mature street trees along the western front of the park and introduce a plaza at the crest of the hill, lighting, signage and other site amenities and thereby improve pedestrian safety and mobility for the community while increasing the use of the western portion of North Oakland's largest City park.

Staff recommends approval of the resolution.

FISCAL IMPACTS

The Engineer's Estimate is \$207,500.00, and the negotiated award amount is \$330,000.00 provided by Beliveau Engineering.

The construction contract is in the amount of \$330,000.00, and the construction contingency is \$33,000.00 (10% of the contract amount). The project has sufficient funds to pay for the construction contract, contingency, design support, and construction management costs of the project.

Sufficient funding to award this contract and complete the project are currently appropriated in the ACTIA Fund (2211), Downtown and Gateway Street Project (G264810) and in the Municipal Capital Improvement Fund (5500), District One Paygo – Bushrod-Edge Park Project (B00520).

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The contractor has a four-month plant establishment period included in the contract price and East Bay Conservation Corps will take over the maintenance of the new trees, shrubs and groundcover for two years.

BACKGROUND

This project will enhance the entrance to Bushrod Park by introducing an eight-foot wide stair that terminates in a new plaza at the crest of the hill. All portions of the park will be accessible from the new plaza. The new trees, shrubs and groundcover will create a safe, enclosed area adjacent to Shattuck Avenue. New signage and pedestrian oriented lighting will also enhance the western entrance of Bushrod Park.

On July 12, 2006, advertisement of the project to solicit bids was placed in the Oakland Tribune and San Francisco Chronicle newspapers, and Notices to Bidders were sent to all contractors holding an "A" License in the City's database and the Daily Pacific Builder.

On August 7, 2006, the City Clerk received and opened two bids for the project as shown in the table below. Bid discounts of 5% for Local Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) participation were applied to these bids. Bid details are presented in the Contract Compliance memo of Attachment A. Astro Construction had both the lowest project bid as well as the lowest bid that incorporated bid discounts. Thus, Astro Construction was initially the lowest responsible bidder. However, Astro Construction failed to produce the required bonds in the specified time and were deemed non responsive.

The next lowest bidder was Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., with a bid of \$369,780.00. This bid was approximately \$170,000.00 over the engineer's estimates and the available budget. Pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Title 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.050.J, which authorizes the purchase of services and supplies on the open market when no valid bids are received in response to a competitive bid process, a contract for the Bushrod Streetscape Improvement Project was successfully negotiated with Beliveau Engineering in an amount not to exceed \$330,000.00.

Thus, Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., is recommended for contract award with a price of \$330,000.00.

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Compliance with City Programs: Beliveau Engineering is in full compliance with City goals for Local and Small Local Business Enterprises. Under the proposed contract, Beliveau Engineering exceeds the City's 20% LBE/SLBE requirement. The bid documents show Local Trucking participation of 100%.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

Construction is scheduled to begin in middle of April 2007 and should be completed by June 2007. The project schedule is contained in Attachment B. The contract specifies \$1,000.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contractor exceeds the contract completion time of 50 working days.

Staff has reviewed the submitted bids for this work and determined that the negotiated bid with Beliveau Engineering is reasonable.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project will enhance the entrance to Bushrod Park by introducing an eight-foot wide stair that terminates in a new stamped colored concrete plaza at the crest of the hill. All portions of the park will be accessible from the new plaza. The new 24-inch box trees, shrubs and groundcover will create a safe enclosed area adjacent to Shattuck Avenue. New signage and pedestrian oriented lighting will also enhance the western entrance of Bushrod Park.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: Over 70% of the work is performed by Oakland based firms, thus providing jobs, and improving the local economy. The project will also improve pedestrian safety and enhance the general aesthetics of community with new and improved stairs, concrete pathway and sidewalk.

<u>Environmental</u>: Air quality will be improved by the new trees, shrubs and groundcover and the entry stair will encourage pedestrian traffic and circulation in the park and the adjacent community. The contractor will be required to make every effort to reuse clean fill materials and use recyclable concrete and asphalt products.

Social Equity: The absence of an entry stair at the west end of Bushrod Park diminishes the level of safety and access for pedestrians to the Bushrod Park. The new stairways with handrails, paved pathway and sidewalk will provide pedestrian accessibility, safer, more livable and cleaner pedestrian access at Shattuck Avenue entrance to Bushrod Park. The improvements will also enhance and identify the western entrance of Bushrod Park and increase the use of the park by the residents.

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DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

The project will construct new paved pathways, sidewalks and stairs that meet the Federal Americans with Disabilities Act. Bushrod Park will be more accessible and safer for all citizens, especially senior citizens and persons with disabilities.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

It is recommended that the City Administrator be authorized by the City Council to award a negotiated construction contract to Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$330,000.00 for the Bushrod Park Streetscape Improvements (Project No. B00520).

The contractor, Beliveau Engineering, has met the LBE/SLBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.



RESOLUTION REJECTIING ALL BIDS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO AWARD A NEGOTIATED CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO BELIVEAU ENGINEERING CONTRACTORS, INC. FOR THE BUSHROD PARK STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS (PROJECT NO. B00520) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED THIRTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$330,000.00)

WHEREAS, the project work consists of an 8-ft. wide entry stair into Bushrod Park, an addition of eighteen mature street trees along the western front of Bushrod Park, a new plaza at the crest of the hill, lighting, signage and other site amenities and thereby improves pedestrian safety and mobility for the community while increasing the use of the western portion of North Oakland's largest City park; and

WHEREAS, the project provides sustainable opportunities to the local economy, environment and social equity for the City of Oakland which meet FY 2005/07 Goals and Objectives of City Council and Mayor, Develop a Sustainable City 1B, and Build Community and Foster Livable Neighborhoods 2C and 2D in that they reduce blight, improve and upgrade the pedestrian amenities and pedestrian safety, and meet the federal Americans with Disabilities Act requirements; and

WHEREAS, on July 12, 2006, advertisement of the project to solicit bids was placed in the Oakland Tribune and San Francisco Chronicle newspapers, and Notices to Bidders were sent to all contractors holding an "A" License in the City's database and the Daily Pacific Builder; and

WHEREAS, on August 7, 2006, the City received two bids, one from Astro Astro Construction which was initially the lowest responsible bidder. However, Astro Construction failed to produce the required bonds in the specified time and were deemed non responsive.

WHEREAS, the other received bid from Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc. was significantly over the engineer's estimate and the available budget and, therefore, deemed not valid; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Oakland Municipal Code Title 2, Chapter 2.04, Section 2.04.050.J, which authorizes the purchase of services and supplies on the open market when no valid bids are received in response to a competitive bid process, a contract for the Bushrod Streetscape Improvement Project was successfully negotiated with Beliveau Engineering in an amount not to exceed \$330,000.00; and

WHEREAS, Beliveau Engineering has met and exceeded the 20% City contract requirements for Local Business Enterprise and Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE); and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds available in the project budget to cover the project costs including the construction contract ten (10%) percent contingency, design support and construction management costs for the project; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funding to award this contract and complete the project are currently appropriated in the ACTIA Fund (2211), Downtown and Gateway Street Project (G264810) and in the Municipal Capital Improvement Fund (5500), District One Pay go – Bushrod-Edge Park Project (B00520); and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under this contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to award a negotiated contract to the most responsible bidder, Beliveau Engineering Contractors, Inc., in accordance with the City Council award set forth above for an amount not to exceed Three Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$330,000.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Director of Public Works for this project are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance is one hundred percent (100%) of the bid amount, and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for the amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, equal to the bid amount, with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all bids previously received for the Bushrod Park Streetscape Improvements (Project No. B00520) are hereby rejected; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
