Attachment 1

Custodial Route Assignments - Monday-Friday, 5:30am-2:00pm Each site on these routes are cleaned one time per day

Route 1

Recreation Centers - 1 FTE Custodian Allendale, Brookdale, Discovery Center, F.M. Smith, Campbell Village, OPD Fruityale Station

Description: This route covers four of the smaller recreation centers that do not require a stationary custodian and the OPD Fruitvale Station which is approximately 150 sq. ft. and takes 20 minutes per day to maintain.

Route 2

Enterprise Facilities - 1 FTE Custodian Leona Lodge, Sequoia Arena, Joaquin Miller Community Center

Description: Enterprise Facilities in the Hill Area - the custodian assigned performs event set-up and breakdown at each of these sites. Detail cleaning and floor care at each these sites is performed by the assigned custodian as well as the day to day cleaning.

Route 3

Larger Facilities - 2 FTE Custodians

Redwood Heights, Shepard's Canyon, Rangers Station, North Oakland Sports Complex, McCrea Pond, Sequoia Arena, Redwood Glen, Joaquin Miller Lower Meadow, Fire Circle

Description: This assignment covers the facilities in the hill area and several stand-alone restrooms.

Route 4

Stand-Alone Restrooms - 2 FTE Custodians

Estuary Park, Sheffield Village, Verdese Carter, Otis Spunk Meyer, Oak Port, Willie Wilkins, Maxwell Park, San Antonio Park, Burkhalter Park, Snow Park, Pine Knoll, Rose Garden, Lafayette Square, Lowell Park, Willow Park, Raimondi Field, Central Reservoir, Lakeview Library Restrooms.

Description: This route consists of stand-alone restrooms at ball fields and parks. The size of these facilities range from 100 sq. ft. to 250 sq. ft.. Each site takes approximately 15-20 minutes to service. Sheffield Village and Verdese Carter are recreation centers assigned to this route.

Route 5

Pools/ Aquatics Centers – 3.0 PPT and 2.0 TPT Custodians Year Round Pools: Lions, Temescal & Live Oak Seasonal Pools: Fremont and Defremery

Description: Water quality functions are handled by two of the PPT Custodians. The cleaning of the pool houses and aquatics centers is performed by the third PPT and the 2.0 FTE / PT conversion employees. Although two of the pools are seasonal, water quality functions, vandalism, graffiti abatement and building maintenance are performed on a regular basis to preserve the condition of the pools and equipment.

Weekend Route - Saturday, Sunday & Holidays, 6:00am-2:30pm

Each site on this route is cleaned one time per day

Stand-Alone Restrooms – 2 TPT Custodians

Otis Spunk Meyer, Oak Port, Willie Wilkins, Arroyo Viejo, Maxwell Park, Dimond Park, San Antonio Park, Estuary Park, Burkhalter Park, Snow Park, Pine Knoll, Rose Garden, Lafayette Square, Lowell Park, Defremery Park, Willow Park, Raimondi Field, Central Reservoir, Lakeview Library Restrooms.

Description: This route consists of stand-alone restrooms at ball fields and parks. The sizes of the facilities range from 100 sq. ft. to 250 sq. ft. This cleaning is performed by two TPT custodians that work 8.0 hours per day Saturday, Sunday and Holidays.
