

**RESOLUTION APPROVING INSTALLATION OF STOP SIGNS ON: 1) 84<sup>th</sup> AVENUE AT E STREET; 2) EAST 31<sup>ST</sup> STREET AT 22<sup>ND</sup> AVENUE; AND 3) GASKILL STREET AT AILEEN STREET**

**WHEREAS**, OMC Section 10.12.110 (C) allows, by resolution, the installation of stop signs based on engineering judgment and practice; and

**WHEREAS**, traffic investigations conducted in response to requests from concerned citizens indicated that the installation of stop signs on 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue at E Street, on East 31<sup>st</sup> Street at 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue, and on Gaskill Street at Aileen Street will enhance traffic and pedestrian safety; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff has determined this action to be categorically exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970 according to Article 19, Section 15301; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the installation of stop signs as described below is hereby approved:

LOCATION OF STOP SIGNS INSTALLATION

- 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue at E Street: This three-leg intersection is currently not controlled on any approach. A stop sign will be installed on the single approach of 84<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
- East 31<sup>st</sup> Street at 22<sup>nd</sup> Avenue: This four-leg intersection is currently not controlled on any approach. Stop signs will be installed on both approaches of East 31<sup>st</sup> Street.
- Gaskill Street at Aileen Street: This four-leg intersection currently has stop signs on both approaches of Aileen Street. Stop signs will be installed on both approaches of Gaskill Street.
