RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAM FOURTH CYCLE STATE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$441,045 FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS AT VARIOUS SCHOOL LOCATIONS
WHEREAS, the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is responsible for disbursing federal funds from the Safe Routes to School (SR2S) Program Fourth Cycle for construction projects that improve pedestrian and bicyclist safety along routes to schools; and
WHEREAS, the Mayor/Council goals include improving pedestrian and bicyclist safety; and
WHEREAS, the City of Oakland applied for and was awarded SR2S Fourth Cycle funds in the amount of \$441,045; and
WHEREAS, the City will provide a local match in the amount of \$100,000 from Transportation Development Act (TDA) funds (Resolution No. 77748, approved on April 15, 2003); now, therefore, be it
RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept and appropriate the Safe Routes to School Program Fourth Cycle funds in the amount of \$441,045; and be it
FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute and submit all documents, payment requests, and related actions, as well as to appropriate any additional grant funds received for the completion of this project.
