Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for the sum of Sixty-One Thousand Six-Hundred Sixty-Seven Dollars and no/cents (\$61,667.00), payable to Jacqueline Dixon and Stephen H. Cornet, her attorney. The co-defendants in the action, Balco Properties and Mandela Properties are contributing an additional amount of One-Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Three-Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars (\$123,333.00) for a total settlement of One-Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$185,000.00).

This action arises out of a trip and fall that occurred on June 10, 2009 on a City sidewalk at 2859 Mandela Parkway. Ms. Dixon was walking to a business at this location when she fell on an uneven sidewalk, causing her to fall and sustain serious injuries that required medical treatment. This matter was heard in closed session on Tuesday, May 7, 2013.
