RE: Resolution Awarding A Construction Contract To R. M. Harris Company, The Lowest, Responsive, Responsible Bidder, For The Seismic Retrofit Of Park Boulevard Viaducts (Project No. C346910), In The Amount Of One Million Six Hundred Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars (\$1,619,184.00)

#### SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared awarding a construction contract in the amount of \$1,619,184.00 to **R**. M. Harris Company for the Seismic Retrofit of Park Boulevard Viaducts (Project No. C346910). The proposed work consists of the seismic retrofit of three viaducts along Park Blvd. between Estates Drive and Monterey Blvd. The work includes the repair of joints, footings, columns in addition to column casing, infill walls, reinforcing steel, traffic control, and environmental protection. The project is located in Council District 4 as shown in *Attachment A*.

This project is funded by a federal and state grant that requires construction contract award by February 28, 2011.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The Engineer's Estimate for the work is \$1,880,000.00. The City of Oakland has received federal and state Proposition 1B funds in the amount of \$2,489,612.00 for the retrofit work of this project. The federal portion of this grant is 88.53% and the state portion is 11.47%. The state portion will serve as a local match for the federal allocation of the grant and the reimbursement will be based on actual cost. Approval of this resolution will authorize the City Administrator to award a construction contract to **R**. M. Harris Company in the amount of \$1,619,184.00. Funding for this contract is available in the following project account:

 Department of Transportation Fund (2116); Capital Improvement Projects-Streets & Structures Organization (92242); Construction Contract Account (57411); Project C346910; \$1,880,000.00.

These are existing bridges for which the City is responsible. The maintenance responsibility will continue, but costs should be reduced by the rehabilitation under this contract.

#### BACKGROUND

On November 4, 2010, the City Clerk received three bids for this project. These bids were rejected due to a clerical error and the project was rebid.

On January 20, 2011, the City Clerk received four bids for this project in the amounts of \$1,619,184.00, \$2,058,253.40, \$2,061,171.75 and \$2,127,423.00. A summary is shown in *Attachment B*. R. M. Harris Company is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and therefore is recommended for the award.

This project is funded by federal funds and state Proposition 1B funds. Therefore, the federal Race Conscious Underutilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (UDBE) Program must be used in lieu of the City's Local/Small Local Business Enterprise (LBE/SLBE) Program in determining qualified bidders. Under the proposed contract with R. M. Harris Company, the UDBE participation will be 6.58%, which exceeds the 3.54% UDBE requirement. The UDBE information has been verified by the Social Equity Division of the Department of Contracting and Purchasing and is shown in *Attachment C*. Staff has reviewed the submitted bid for this work and has determined that the bid is reasonable for the current construction climate.

#### **KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS**

The improvements to these viaducts are funded by federal and state Proposition 1B funds as part of the Seismic Safety Retrofit Program. The retrofit work is intended to strengthen these bridges and viaducts to resist future earthquakes, a likely event. The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) requires that the contract be awarded by February 28, 2011.

This project was first bid in November 2010. However due to a clerical error, the project was rebid in January 2011. The City was just notified by Caltrans that the original deadline for award of this construction contract had not changed. Therefore the construction contract has to be awarded by February 28, 2011.

Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2011 and should be completed by December 2011. The contract specifies 1,800.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract is not completed within 175 working days. The project schedule is shown in *Attachment B*.

#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

In general, the proposed work consists of the seismic retrofit of three viaducts along Park Blvd. between Estates Drive and Monterey Blvd. The work includes the repair of joints, footings, columns in addition to column casing, infill walls, reinforcing steel, traffic control, environmental protection, and other ancillary work as indicated on the plans and specifications.

### EVALUATION OF PAST PERFORMANCE

There is no past performance evaluation on file for R. M. Harris Company.

### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

*Economic*: This project will improve bridge seismic reliability ensuring continued safe use of the viaducts and the roadways they support.

*Environmental*: Environmental factors and opportunities will be considered and incorporated to the extent feasible. The projects will consider the use of recycled materials in the products specified and integrate other environmental opportunities, waste reduction and energy conservation to the extent possible.

*Social Equity*: The seismic retrofit of these bridges will enhance pedestrian and vehicular safety in the neighborhoods.

### DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

During construction, the contractor will be required to provide safe and accessible travel through the construction area. Temporary access that is in full compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) will be provided for seniors and persons with disabilities during construction.

#### **RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE**

It is recommended that the construction contract be awarded to R. M. Harris Company, the lowest responsive responsible bidder, in the amount of \$1,619,184.00 for the Seismic Retrofit of Park Blvd. Viaducts (Project No. C346910). R. M. Harris Company has met the DBE and UDBE requirements, and there are sufficient funds in the project account.

In order to meet the funding deadline this construction contract has to be awarded by the City Council by February 28, 2011.

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### ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.


