RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO R. M. HARRIS COMPANY, THE LOWEST, RESPONSIVE, RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, FOR THE SEISMIC RETROFIT OF PARK BOULEVARD VIADUCTS (PROJECT NO. C346910), IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE MILLION SIX HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED EIGHTY-FOUR DOLLARS (\$1,619,184.00)

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2010, three bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland for the Seismic Retrofit of Park Boulevard Viaducts (Project No. C346910); and

WHEREAS, the November 4, 2010 bids were rejected due to a clerical error and the project was rebid; and

WHEREAS, on January 20, 2011, four bids were received by the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Oakland for this project; and

WHEREAS, R. M. Harris Company bidding as a prime, is deemed the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for the project; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the project budget for the work in the following project account:

 Department of Transportation Fund (2116); Capital Improvement Projects-Streets & Structures Organization (92242); Construction Contract Account (57411); Project C346910; \$1,880,000.00

WHEREAS, R. M. Harris Company complies with the federal Underutilized Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (UDBE) Program requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the City lacks the equipment and qualified personnel to perform the necessary work, that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy or better performance and that this contract is of a professional, scientific or technical and temporary nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has determined that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the construction contract for the Seismic Retrofit of Park Boulevard Viaducts (Project No. C346910) is hereby awarded to R. M. Harris Company in accordance with the project plans and specifications and the contractor's bid therefore, dated January 20, 2011, in the amount of One Million Six Hundred Nineteen Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Four Dollars (\$1,619,184.00); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the plans and specifications prepared by the Assistant Director of the Public Works Agency for this project are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance, \$1,619,184.00, and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for the amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, \$1,619,184.00, with respect to such work are hereby approved; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with R. M. Harris Company on behalf of the City of Oakland and to execute any amendments or modifications to said contract within the limitations of the project specifications; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all other bids are hereby rejected; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
