An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 13024 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule), as Amended, to Establish, Modify and Delete Fees Assessed by the Office of the City Administrator, Office of the City Clerk, Finance and

Management Agency, Oakland Police Department, Oakland Fire Department, Oakland Public Library, Office of Parks and Recreation, Department of Human

Services, Public Works Agency, and the Community and Economic

Development Agency.

SUMMARY

The attached ordinance amends Ordinance Number 13024 C.M.S. (the FY 2011-12 Master Fee Schedule, or "MFS"), to establish, modify and delete fees and penalties assessed by the Office of the City Administrator, Office of the City Clerk, Finance and Management Agency, Oakland Police Department, Oakland Fire Department, Oakland Public Library, Office of Parks and Recreation, Department of Human Services, Public Works Agency, and the Community and Economic Development Agency.

In most cases, changes to fees are required to offset changes in costs related to the provision of services for which fees are charged. The changes in fees (added or modified) are intended to meet the requirements of Proposition 26. In areas where fee comparisons are applicable, the City of Oakland's fees are similar to other neighboring jurisdictions. Specific, new, modified or deleted fees can be found in *Exhibit A* attached to the Ordinance.

FISCAL IMPACT

The revenue generated from the fee changes and from fees not changing is anticipated at \$137 million for all funds and \$26 million for the General Purpose Fund. The revenues from fees are included in the FY 2011-12 Budget, and any modifications to the fee proposal would impact budget balancing. The additional anticipated revenue will help offset increases in costs to provide services for which the increased fees are charged, with no net gain.

DISCUSSION

A. Fee Changes Proposed for Council Approval

The proposed ordinance shows proposed changes to the Master Fee Schedule for FY 2011-12, for City Council adoption. Fees not changing are not presented (i.e., if the fee is the same for the proposed FY 2011-12 as in FY 2010-11, they are not included in this report).

The Master Fee Schedule changes not yet approved by the City Council, and attached, are summarized below. In the attachment, deleted fees have a strikethrough and new items have an underline.

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Budget Office: FY 2011-12 Master Fee Schedule

- The Office of the City Administrator is proposing to add, delete and modify fees to the following categories with no anticipated increase in revenues above those estimated in the FY 2011-12 Proposed Budget. The fees for the most part would be charged to non-City related departments.
 - a. Special Activities: The proposed fee modifications are designed to recoup actual costs for time spent by City Administrator staff in administering Chapter 5.64 of the City Charter. The fees are intended to meet actual time spent reviewing, accepting, monitoring, problem solving, and providing general oversight of the Taxicab ordinance. These modifications are intended to allow the Special Business Permit Division to recover actual costs. The following are the proposed changes:
 - 1. Modification of fees for Driver's initial and renewal permits;
 - 2. Deletion of fees and addition of new fees for Operating permits (taxi stand installation and maintenance, and inspection fees);
 - 3. Modification and addition of new fees for Vehicle Permits (issuance of medallion, application and insurance fees); and
 - 4. Modification of fees for Fleet Management Company permits.
 - b. KTOP- Production Services: KTOP proposes to amend, add new and delete fees for Stage Rental Equipment. The amended fees are intended to be adjusted to meet market rates for similar or like equipment in the Bay Area. The adding of new fees for Stage Rental Equipment is intended to meet market rates and customer service needs for single pieces of stage equipment. The fees deleted are for stage equipment that is outdated or no longer in use.
 - 1. Modification of fees, addition of new fees for videocassette duplication;
 - 2. Modification of fees, addition of new fees for On-line studio production editing equipment rental and Individual Lights;
 - 3. Modification of fees, addition of new fees and deletion of fees for the Single Camera D9 Production Package with Lights and Sound;
 - 4. Deletion and modification of fees for Switched D9 Filed Event with 2-3 Cameras; and
 - 5. Modification of fees for Butterflies and Overheads and Backdrops.
- 2. The Office of the City Clerk is proposing to modify the Passport Photo fee from \$10 for 2 photos to \$10 for 1 photo. The fee is intended to recover costs time and material to provide passport documentation. The US Dept of State is no longer requiring that two photos be presented for a passport. The \$10 fee remains the same because staff s time to administer the passport photos is the same regardless of the number of photos taken, and the photo will continue to print on one sheet of photo paper.
- 3. The Finance and Management Agency (FMA) is proposing to add a new fee for a Priority Demand Letter Fee. The fee is intended to recover the costs of processing priority requests. The Revenue Division in FMA is proposing to modify the New

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Business Registration fee. The fee is intended to recover the administrative costs in accordance with City policies. The Risk Management Division of FMA is proposing to establish new fees for Liability Insurance for Encroachments into the Public Right-of-Way and Vendor/Contractors Liability (not including premiums). The Liability Insurance for Encroachments fee is intended to offset insurance premium costs where the Risk Management Division has secured a blanket insurance policy designed to enable those seeking any permits (that require insurance) to meet the City's insurance requirements. The Vendor/Contractors Liability insurance fee is intended to cover staffitime spent to administer the new function not inclusive of premium costs.

- 4. The Oakland Police Department is proposing to primarily realign fee descriptions to functions. The adding of a new Vehicle Releases- Non- refundable Administrative fee is intended to recoup the costs of processing and administrating a request from the public who choose not to pick up their vehicles and request a refund. The fee changes are in the following areas:
 - a. Modification of language for the Redemption Fee for Claiming an Impounded Animal by deleting "Redemption Home" in Item 1.d;
 - b. Deletion of the Recovery of Emergency Response Expenses for Ranger, which is no longer valid;
 - c. Modification of language for Dangerous and Vicious Dog Permit by deleting "License" in item AD I and 2;
 - d. Addition of a new Non-refundable Administrative fee for Vehicle Releases;
 - for Modification of language for the Micro Chip for Oakland resident fee by deleting "Animal Adopter";
 - g. Modification of language for the Animal Owner Property Inspection fee by deleting "Penalty for 2nd Inspection to Enforce Dangerous Dog"; and
 - h. Modification of language for the Surrender of Animal to the Oakland Animal Shelter fee by relocating "Levied after 5 animals surrendered per individual within 12 month period" and modifying the fee in BA 3.
- 5. The Oakland Fire Department is proposing to modify the majority of existing fees by an average of 5 percent for the following sections. The fee changes are intended to recover the cost of staff and materials to administer, permit, inspect facilities, and activities for fire safety. The fee changes are in the following areas:
 - Administration services;
 - b. Permits;
 - c. Inspections;
 - d. Certified Unified Program Agency (CUPA);
 - e. Hazardous Fire Area;
 - f. Public Education or Training; and
 - g. Incident Recovery fees.
- 6. The Oakland Public Library is proposing to add new fees, modify fees and delete various fees. The addition of fees for rental of library meeting rooms is intended to standardize rates across all Library facilities and to recoup the cost of maintenance and

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custodial activities. The fee changes at the African American Museum Library are intended to be more in-line with recouping the full costs of staff and custodial activities. The changes in fees for overdue library materials, printing, copying and mailing are intended to recoup the costs of materials and activities. The following are the proposed changes:

- a. Rental of:Library Meeting Rooms;
- b. Delete Overdue Fines on Adult Materials Other Than Electronic Media:
- c. Delete Overdue Fines on Electronic Media;
- d. Modify and add new fees for Overdue Fines;
- e. Delete the Tool Lending Library Fines;
- fe Modify and add new fees for printing from a Public Access Computer; and
- g. Modify fees for Floppy Disks and Copying & Mailing materials.
- 7. The Office of Parks and Recreation (OPR) is proposing to add, delete and modify fees to the categories listed. OPR fee increases have been properly forecasted and are reflected in the FY 2011-12 Proposed Budget. The fees are directly charged to those utilizing parks, recreation facilities, and recreation center programs and activities. The fees charged are intended to offset staff costs and meet basic maintenance and supply needs.
 - a. Administration
 - 1. Oakland Zoo (for information purposes only, the Zoo sets fees and retains revenues to offset operational costs incurred);
 - 2. New fees for Park Use Permits;
 - 3. Rental Facilities:
 - 4. Service Fees:
 - 5. Field Rental; and
 - 6. Community Gardens.
 - b. Malonga Casquelourd Center- fee changes for facilities use and equipment; and new fees for private and non-profits; and changes to monthly rates SRO units.
 - c. Recreational Services-
 - 1. Aquatics- boat rentals, boating programs and swimming pool reservations;
 - 2. Tennis Court reservations:
 - 3. Golf Course rates; and
 - 4. New fees for the East Oakland Sports Complex.
- 8. The Department of Human Services is proposing to add a new \$3 Senior Center Parking Sticker fee for the Downtown Oakland Center. The new fee would be applied to senior center members who wish to park their personal vehicle in the Veterans' Memorial Building parking lot. The fee is assessed per vehicle each year and is intended to help defray a portion of the administrative and material costs of the parking stickers.
- 9. The Public Works Agency (PWA) is proposing to add, delete and modify fees. The new fees are intended to recover the costs of materials and actual staff costs. The deleted fees are intended to be realigned or are no longer valid. The changes in fees are not

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anficipated to increase revenues above those estimated in the FY 2011-12 Proposed Budget. PWA changes are in the following categories:

- a. Transportation;
- b. Keep Oakland Clean & Beautiful;
- c. Environmental Services;
- d. Electrical & Energy Efficiency; and
- e. Street & Sidewalk Maintenance.
- 10. The Community and Economic Development Agency (CEDA) is proposing to add new fees for courier services to expedite recording of documents; a notice served by summons process fee as required by nuisance abatement liens; and a new construction & activity surcharge for special findings fee for complex projects to meet added review. Each of the new fees is intended to recoup the costs of services provided. All other changes are to clarify fee descriptions. CEDA changes are in the following categories:
 - a. Building Services- Administration and Code Enforcement;
 - b. Planning and Zoning; and
 - c. Miscellaneous-Jobs/Housing Fee.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council accept this report and adopt the proposed ordinance amending the Master Fee Schedule, as attached. Once adopted, the amended fees will become effective July 1, 2011.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 13024 C.M.S. (MASTER FEE SCHEDULE), AS AMENDED, TO ESTABLISH, MODIFY AND DELETE FEES ASSESSED BY THE OFFICE OF THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK, FINANCE AND **MANAGEMENT** AGENCY, OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT. OAKLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT, OAKLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY, OFFICE OF PARKS AND RECREATION, DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES PULIC WORKS AGENCY, AND THE COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland periodically updates its Master Fee Schedule to account for general cost of living increases and program changes or other costs; and

WHEREAS, the fee modifications and additions proposed herein have been justified by the respective agencies and are identified in an "Agenda Report" dated June 21, 2011 to P. Lamont Ewell, City Administrator, entitled "An Ordinance Amending Ordinance Number 13024 C.M.S. (Master Fee Schedule), as Amended, to Establish, Modify, and Delete Fees Assessed by selected Offices, Departments, and Agencies of the City of Oakland"; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the herein-referenced modifications and additions are necessary to reimburse the City for the costs of performing the various municipal and regulatory functions; and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing was held on June 21, 2011, to review the proposed fee changes: now, therefore

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Master Fee Schedule as set forth in Ordinance Number 13024 C.M.S., as amended, is hereby amended to modify and establish fees assessed by the Office of the City Administrator, Office of the City Clerk, Finance and Management Agency, Oakland Police Department, Oakland Fire Department, Oakland Public Library, Office of Parks and Recreation, Department of Human Services, Public Works Agency and the Community and Economic Development Agency and as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof

Section 2. This ordinance shall be effective on July 1, 2011 upon approval by the Council of the City of Oakland.


