RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HER DESIGNEE TO:

- 1) ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE ALAMEDA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE (ACSO) FOR FIRE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL SERVICES THAT THE CITY OF OAKLAND WILL PROVIDE IN CONNECTION WITH THE BAY AREA URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2014, UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT PROGRAM; AND
- 2) ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE AND ADMINISTER THE UASI GRANT ALLOCATION OF UP TO \$150,000 FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2014, FOR THE REIMBURSEMENT OF SALARIES AND BENEFITS PAID TOTHE OAKLAND FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR STAFF ASSIGNED AS A TRAINING AND EXERCISE PROGRAM OFFICER FOR THE BAYAREA UASI REGIONAL TRAINING AND EXERCISE PROGRAM; AND
- 3) WAIVE THE CITY OF OAKLAND CENTRAL SERVICES OVERHEAD (CSO) FEES THAT ARE APPROXIMATELY TWENTY FOUR THOUSAND AND ELEVEN DOLLARS (\$24,011) PER FISCAL YEAR AFFILIATED WITH THE FY2014 UASI SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security allocates grant funds to address unique planning, equipment and training and exercise needs of high-threat, high density Urban Area to assist in building enhanced and sustainable capacities to prevent, protect against, respond to and recover from acts of terrorism and all hazards events; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department, Emergency Management Services Division will be allocated federal Fiscal year (FY) 2014 supplemental Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funds to supplement emergency preparedness training and exercise activities within the City of Oakland and the Bay Area Region, and in alignment with the Alameda County Sheriff's Office (ACSO) who has a contract with the Bay Area UASI region to provide comprehensive Regional Training and Exercise Program; and

WHEREAS, the Oakland Fire Department, Emergency Management Services Division receives FY2012 UASI supplemental grant funding from the Bay Area UASI Approval Authority for other authorized training, exercises and professional development programs, as well as FY2012 UASI grant funding for a Training and Exercise Officer position that will be administered by ACSO; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Fire Department, Emergency Management Services Division's personnel will provide services in connection with the operation and execution of the UASI Bay Area Regional Training and Exercise Program from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, or until grant funding is exhausted through a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with ACSO in order to receive the supplemental UASI grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the supplemental grant funding of up to \$150,000 will be used to reimburse the Oakland Fire Department, Emergency Management Services Division for a Training Program Officer's salary and benefits from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the central service overhead costs in the amount of \$24,011 will be waived; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with ACSO to provide personnel services in connection with the Bay Area UASI Regional Training Program in exchange for the FY2014 supplemental UASI grant allocation of up to \$150,000 to pay for the Oakland Fire Department, EMSD Training Program Officer position's salary and benefits from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015, or until grant funding is exhausted in connection with the FY2014 UASI supplemental grant funding; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept, appropriate and administer the supplemental FY2014 UASI grant funding allocation of up to \$150,000 for reimbursement of salaries and benefits; and be

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the waiving of the City of Oakland Central Services Overhead (CSO) Fees that are approximately Twenty four thousand and eleven dollars (\$24,011) per fiscal year affiliated with the FY2014 UASI Supplemental grant; and be it

FURTHUR RESOLVED: That revenues and appropriations will be allocated to the Homeland Security Grant Fund (2123), the Emergency Management Services Division Organization (20711), Emergency Management Services Program (PS 21), FY2014 UASI Supplemental grant project number to be determined and that EMSD will be reimbursed for actual salary and benefits used for the Training Officer position assigned to ACSO for the Regional Training and Exercise program up to \$150,000 of eligible expenses; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes that the City Administrator, as agent of the City, or her designee, is herby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances, and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award and fulfill the grant requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreement(s) authorized hereunder shall be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
