ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE TO ENACT THE CITY OF OAKLAND AFFORDABLE HOUSING AND INFRASTRUCTURE BOND LAW, WHICH PROVIDES FOR ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS TO FUND THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROGRAM AND OTHER PURPOSES DESCRIBED HEREIN

This Ordinance amends the Oakland Municipal Code to enact an Affordable Housing and Infrastructure Bond Law for the City that sets forth a procedure by which the City may issue general obligation bonds for certain affordable housing and infrastructure purposes, and establishes a program for such affordable housing purposes as provided in the Law.

Notice of Publication

This Ordinance was introduced as amended at the City Council meeting, Tuesday evening November 14, 2016, to revise section 4.54.210 - Prioritization of program, by adding to the first sentence "helping those who are homeless and" to make it read: "The top priority for the City's affordable housing bond funds will be helping those who are homeless and protecting vulnerable Oaklanders from being displaced from their homes." It passed to print 8 Ayes. Final adoption has been scheduled for the City Council meeting Tuesday evening November 29, 2016, 5:30 p.m., at One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, Council Chamber, 3rd floor, Oakland, California.
