WHEREAS, the City Council found that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property had arisen within the City, caused by the December 28, 2005 to January 4, 2006 winter storms; and

WHEREAS, the City ratified the January 5, 2006 proclamation of a local emergency under Resolution No. 79669 C.M.S. on January 12, 2006 as required by California Government Code Section 8630; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 8630 also requires that the governing body shall review, at its regularly scheduled meetings until the local emergency is terminated, the need for continuing the local emergency; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby confirms the continued existence of the local emergency declared on January 5, 2006 throughout the City of Oakland; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that during the existence of said local emergency the powers, functions, and duties of the emergency organization of this City shall be those prescribed by state law, and the charter, ordinances, resolutions, and approved plans of the City of Oakland.
