INTRODUCED BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT PATRICIA KERNIGHAN

**RESOLUTION APPOINTING ELIZABETH ANDERS AS THE CITY
OF OAKLAND'S TRUSTEE TO THE ALAMEDA COUNTY
MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT BOARD**

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District was formed in 1930 pursuant to the Mosquito Abatement Districts Act authorizing formation of mosquito control districts in the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the California Health and Safety Code governs the creation of mosquito abatement districts; and

WHEREAS, Section 2021 of the California Health & Safety Code stipulates that a city council may appoint one person as a trustee to its district ; and

WHEREAS, Marisel Brown's two-year term as the City's appointed trustee expired on January 1, 2012, and the position is now vacant; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Rules of Procedure (Resolution No. 82580 C.M.S.) provide that "the President of the Council shall recommend appointments to regional and local boards and agencies, as appropriate, subject to confirmation by the Council"; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that Elizabeth Anders, an Oakland resident, is hereby appointed as a Trustee of the Alameda County Mosquito Abatement District Board, effectively immediately, for a term ending December 31, 2013.
