Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and recommends settlement of the above-entitled matter arising from an incident on September 11, 2001, in which plaintiff tripped on cracked pavement in the crosswalk at the intersection of MacArthur Boulevard and Webster Street and fell to the ground.

Due to the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances, settlement is recommended in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$6,000), to be made payable to Jean E. Newton and William L. Berg, Esq., her attorney of record.
