

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO RAY'S ELECTRIC FOR INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT SEMINARY AVENUE AND OUTLOOK AVENUE, AND AT MACARTHUR BOULEVARD AND RICHARDS ROAD FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED SIXTY ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY DOLLARS (\$161,720)

WHEREAS, on September 11, 2000, two bids were received by the City Clerk for the intersection improvements at Seminary Avenue and Outlook Avenue (Project No. B01000), and at MacArthur Boulevard and Richards Road (Project No. B01010); and

WHEREAS, Ray's Electric is the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the bids ranged from \$161,720 to \$192,350; and

WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds in the project budget for the construction, and the project budget is \$177,892; and

WHEREAS, the City lacks the staff resources to perform the necessary work; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract is in the public interest because of economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the contract for the intersection improvements at Seminary Avenue and Outlook Avenue, and at MacArthur Boulevard and Richards Road is hereby awarded to Ray's Electric in accordance with the terms of its bid, dated September 11, 2000 for an amount not to exceed one hundred and sixty one thousand, seven hundred and twenty dollars (\$161,720); and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the amount of the bond for faithful performance, eighty thousand, eight hundred and sixty dollars (\$80,860) and the amount for a bond to guarantee payment of all claims for labor and materials furnished and for amount due under the Unemployment Insurance Act, one hundred and sixty one thousand, seven hundred and twenty dollars (\$161,720), with respect to such work are hereby approved; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Ray's Electric on behalf of the City of Oakland and to execute any amendments, or modifications of said agreement, with the exception of the increase in the contract amount; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That all other bids are hereby rejected; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk is hereby directed to post conspicuously forthwith notice of the above award on the official bulletin board in the Office of the City Clerk.
