RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE KPA GROUP FOR ADDITIONAL AS-NEEDED ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) FOR A TOTAL CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000.00)

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2004, Council Resolution No. 78393 C.M.S. awarded an as-needed architectural services contract to The KPA Group for a not to exceed amount of \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, tasks for various projects have fully utilized the initial contract amount; and

WHEREAS, additional as-needed professional services are required for the evaluation, design, and construction support of the Police Administration Building Retrofit project, the Live Oak Pool Deck Repairs project, and other ongoing projects; and

WHEREAS, The KPA Group can provide the additional design and construction support services in the most efficient and cost effective manner because of their familiarity and current involvement in these ongoing projects; and

WHEREAS, funds for the Police Administration Building Retrofit project are available from the FEMA Hazard Mitigation Grant (Fund 2146, Project No. C58691; Organization No. 92270, Account No. 54411); funds for the Live Oak Pool Deck Repair project are available from the Proposition 40 Per Capita Grant (Fund 2134, Project No. G251110, Organization No. 92270, Account No. 54411); funds for other ongoing projects will be identified prior to the performance of the architectural services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services provided pursuant to the agreement authorized hereunder are of a professional, scientific or technical nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, Council finds that this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the services are exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Section 2.04.050 I (1) of the Oakland Municipal Code; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to enter into Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement with The KPA Group to provide additional architectural design and construction support services for an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$350,000.00; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or her designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement with the exception of those related to an increase in the total dollar amount of the agreement, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the contract shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


