

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO EXECUTE A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND NATIONAL MEDICAL SERVICES, INCREASING THE AMOUNT BY SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000) FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$129,900) FOR BLOOD AND URINE TESTING

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this contract is for services of a professional nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that services under the contract will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; and

WHEREAS, contracts requiring professional or specialized services are exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to chapter 2.04 of the Oakland Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, National Medical Services currently has a contract with the City to provide chemical testing for the Police Department for the period of July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2003; and

WHEREAS, said contract was amended to add \$50,000 for a total amount not to exceed \$69,900, authorized by City Council Resolution No. 77033 C.M.S., dated March 26, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department requires additional services beyond the amount stated in the amended contract with National Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department has identified \$60,000 for additional funding for National Medical Services in the State Asset Forfeiture Funds (Fund: 2914, Organization Code: 104631, Project: H21600); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute a second amendment the professional services agreement with National Medical Services to increase the amount from \$69,900 to \$129,000 for the period July 1, 2001 to June 30, 2003; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute any further documents necessary to implement this resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Manager is authorized to modify, extend or amend said agreement provided that no additional funds will be allocated without prior Council approval and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreement shall be reviewed by the City Attorney as to form and legality and a copy placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND
AND NATIONAL MEDICAL SERVICES**

This **Second Amendment** to the Professional Services Agreement Between the City of Oakland, a municipal corporation, (hereinafter "City") and National Medical Services, (hereinafter "Contractor") dated January 1, 2003 (the Agreement), increases the amount of compensation.

Changes are made to the agreement as follows:

Compensation and Method of Payment

The amount of compensation shall be increased by \$60,000 for the performance of additional services needed to accomplish the blood and urine testing required by the Police Department for a total compensation amount not to exceed \$129,900.

All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
