Grade Level



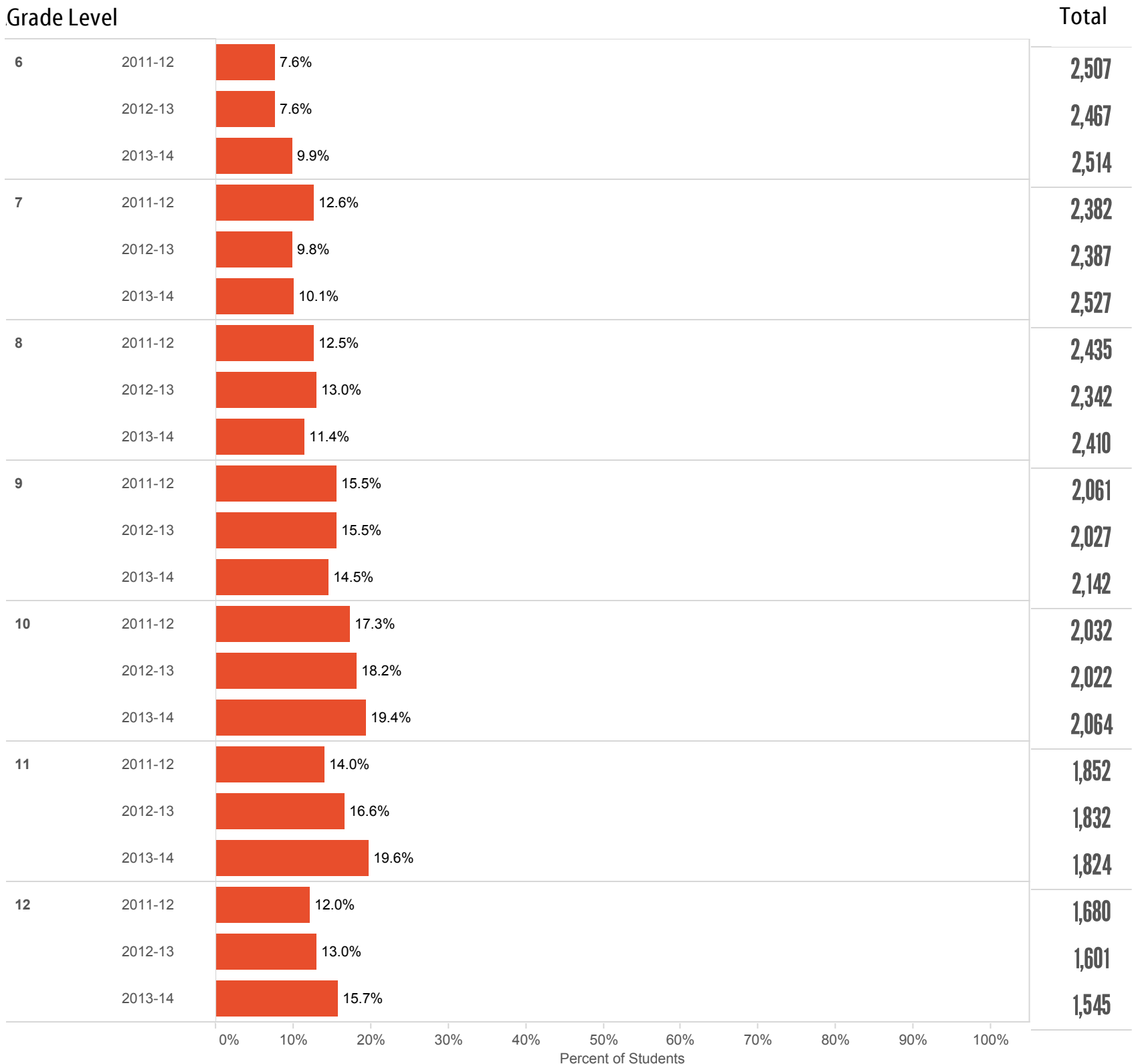

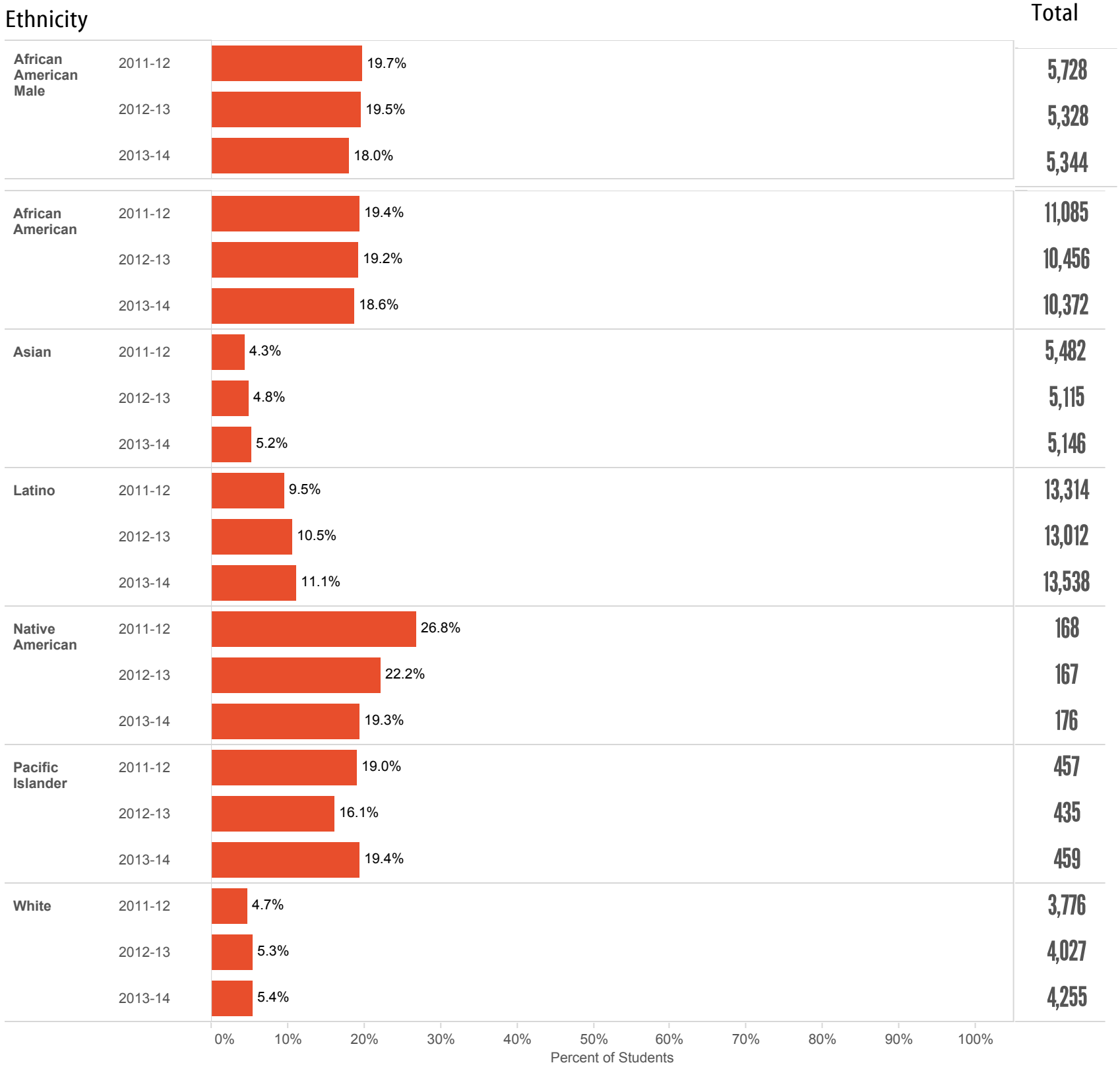

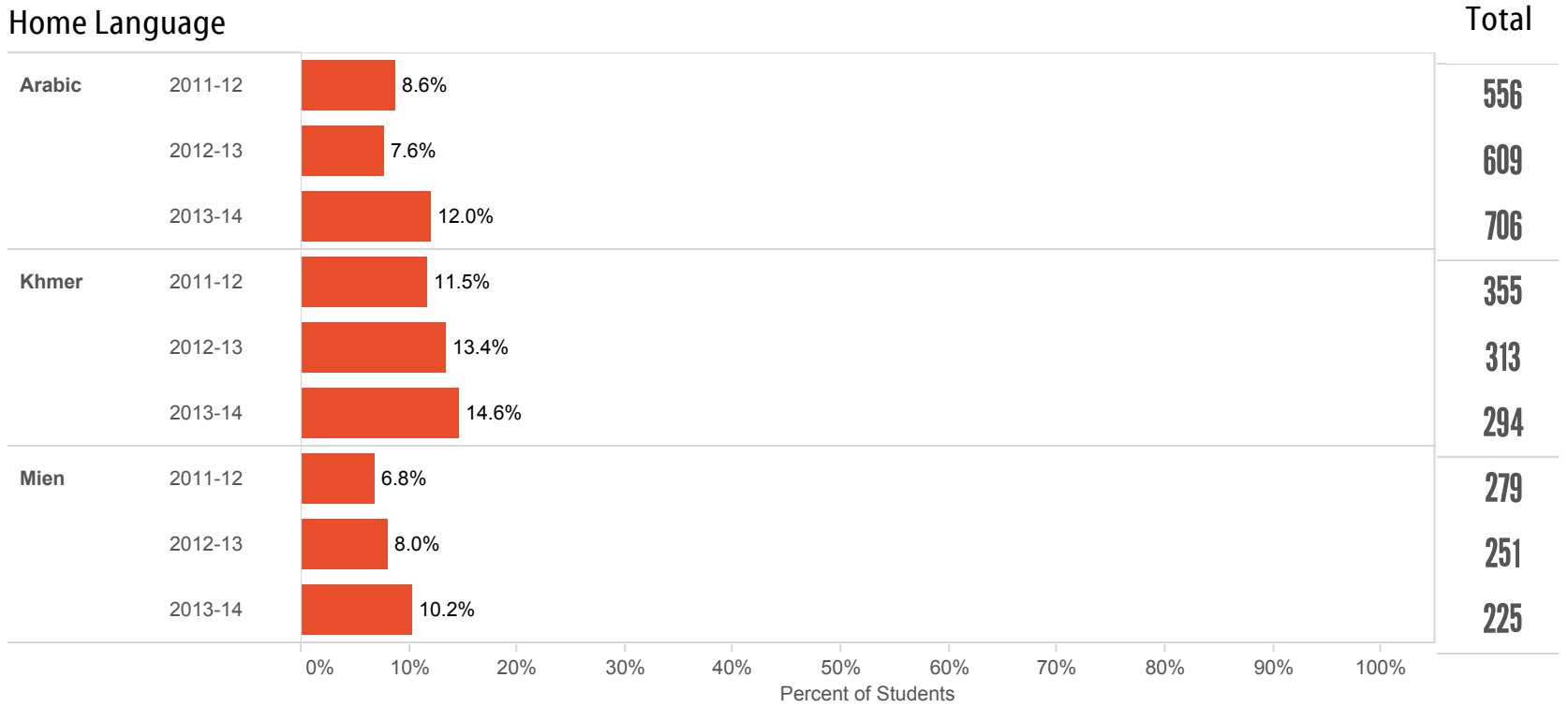
