

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE USE OF \$350.00 OF COUNCILMEMBER PATRICIA KERNIGHAN'S DISTRICT TWO SPECIAL PRIORITY FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR REPLACEMENT OAK TREES FOR MANDANA BOULEVARD, AND AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF SAID FUNDS FROM COUNCILMEMBER PATRICIA KERNIGHAN'S DISTRICT TWO SPECIAL PRIORITY FUNDS TO THE PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY

WHEREAS, Councilmember Patricia Kernighan wishes to use \$350.00 of District Two Special Priority Funds for purchase of four replacement oak trees for Mandana Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, this requires City Council approval to transfer said funds to the Public Works Agency; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the use of Councilmember Patricia Kernighan's District Two Special Priority Funds in the amount of \$350.00 for the purchase of four replacement oak trees for Mandana Boulevard; and

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to transfer \$350.00 from Councilmember Patricia Kernighan's District Two Special Priority Funds to the Public Works Agency for the above purpose.



RESOLUTION DECLARING OCTOBER 2010 UNITED NATIONS MONTH AND OCTOBER 24TH 2010 UNITED NATIONS DAY IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO SERVE AS AN HONORARY SPONSOR OF THE UNITED NATIONS MONTH AND DAY CELEBRATIONS RAISING

WHEREAS, since its founding in San Francisco on October 24, 1945 by 50 Charter Members led by John S. McLaughlin, the United Nations has been a beacon to other nations, large and small, in the areas of Human Rights, Security; and

WHEREAS, the City and Port of Oakland and the United Nations both hold annual celebrations outdoors, at Jack London Square, and the United Nations both endeavor to foster the global education and perspective of the United Nations.

WHEREAS, the Port of Oakland is the largest port on the West Coast, and the City of Oakland's diverse population and activities of cultural, scientific and educational significance.

WHEREAS, many organizations in the City of Oakland are devoted to the universal development of human rights, adequate food and shelter, health care, environmental preservation, educational standards, artistic freedom, and acceptance of religious diversity; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland is proud of the efforts of both its own citizens and of those in other nations to encourage the opening of minds and hearts to one another in the pursuit of a more peaceful and livable world; and

WHEREAS, we believe that these attributes of Oakland and its citizens lead us to admire and support the tenets of the United Nations; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council of the City of Oakland does declare October 2010 to be United Nations Month and October 24th 2010 United Nations Day in the City of Oakland, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Oakland City Council urges Oakland citizens to focus on the welfare of its youth and to salute them by participating in the United Nations Flag Raising Ceremony October 23, 2010, at Jack London Square, as we honor the mission, spirit and potential of the United Nations.
