RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A GRANT OF \$5,527.60 FROM COUNCILMEMBER JEAN QUAN'S PAY-GO FUNDS TO THE LAUREL DISTRICT ASSOCIATION FOR THE DESIGN, FABRICATION AND INSTILLATION OF THIRTY-FIVE STREET BANNERS

WHEREAS, on July 17, 2007, the City Council revised the Pay-Go procedures to limit Pay-Go uses to City of Oakland infrastructure, furniture or equipment expenditures, or to grant to other government agencies for infrastructure, furniture or equipment expenditures; and

WHEREAS, any expenditures for purposes other than City or other government infrastructure, furniture, or equipment require council approval; and

WHEREAS, Councilmember Jean Quan wishes to grant a portion of her Pay-Go funds to the Laurel District Association for the design, fabrication and instillation of thirty-five street banners; and

WHEREAS, in conformance with City requirements, the Laurel District Association will provide documentation for the use of the Councilmember's Pay-Go funds; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council authorizes the grant of \$5,527.60 from Councilmember Jean Quan's Pay-Go fund to the Laurel District Association for the design, fabrication and instillation of thirty-five street banners; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Administrator is authorized to execute an appropriate grant agreement with the Laurel District Association for the above purpose, subject to approval as to form and legality by the City Attorney.
