Transfer Taxes

SUMMARY

On December 16, 2003, pursuant to Chapter 4.20 of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing for delinquent Real Estate Transfer Taxes was held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners prior to the public hearing before City Council.

A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on 6 accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges, should they remain unpaid at the time of the City's submission to the County Assessor.

FISCAL IMPACT

Property owners owe the City delinquent real property transfer taxes and administrative fees for the accounts not resolved at the November 13th 2003 administrative hearings. Failure to place a lien to recover the tax will result in an estimated loss of \$18,702.70 revenue to the City's General Fund.

BACKGROUND

The City notified property owners of the City's intent to record a lien against their property. Seven cases were resolved and removed from the list of delinquent properties.

A resolution has been prepared confirming the placement of liens on 6 accounts and authorizing the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

There are no key issues or impacts.

POLICY DESCRIPTION

Pursuant to Chapter 4.20 of the Oakland Municipal Code, an administrative hearing for delinquent Real Estate Transfer Taxes is held to hear protests and resolve any inconsistencies or inequities raised by property owners prior to the public hearing before City Council.

There are no sustainable opportunities that are being addressed by this report.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends that the City Council pass the resolution confirming the placement of liens on all unpaid accounts and authorize the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges should they remain unpaid prior to the transfer of said assessment to the County Assessor for inclusion on the next property tax assessment.

There are no alternative recommendations.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

The City Council is requested to approve the placement of liens on all unpaid accounts and authorize the subsequent assessment for all fees and charges should they remain unpaid prior to the transfer of said assessment to the County Assessor for inclusion on the next property tax assessment.
