OMC 8.22.070 Rent Adjustment For Occupied Covered Units; Section B

 Calculation of the CPI Rent Adjustment. Beginning in 2002 until July 31, 2022. the CPI Rent

Adjustment is the average of the percentage increase in the CPI—All items and the CPI—Less shelter

for the twelve (12) month period starting on March 1 of each calendar year and ending on the last day

of February of the following calendar year calculated to the nearest one tenth of one percent.

Beginning on August 1, 2022, the CPI Rent Adjustment is (1) sixty percent (60%) of the percentage

increase in the CPI - All Items published for April of that calendar year from April of the immediately

preceding calendarVear calculated to the nearest one tenth of one percent, or (2) three percent (3%), whichever is lower.

• If the percentage increase in the CPI-All Items exceeds three percent, the amount by which the

percentage increase in the CPI-All Items exceeds three percent (3%) may be banked and taken in

subsequent years when the CPI Ail Items is less than three percent, un to a maximum of three percent,
