Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator To Award A Contract To Construct The Substructure For The San Pablo Pedestrian Streetlights Project On San Pablo Avenue, Between The Emeryville (53<sup>rd</sup> Street) And Berkeley (67<sup>th</sup> Street) Borders In Accord With Specifications For Project No. C315010 and Contractor's Bid Therefore, To The Lowest Responsible, Responsive Bidder, Ray's Electric, Inc., In An Amount Not To Exceed Six Hundred Seventeen

Thousand Five Hundred Two Dollars (\$617,502.00)

#### **SUMMARY**

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator, or his designee, to award a construction contract in the amount of \$617,502.00 to Ray's Electric, Inc., for the San Pablo Pedestrian Streetlights Project (Project C315010). The project is located on San Pablo Avenue, between the Emeryville Border (53<sup>rd</sup> Street), and the Berkeley Border (67<sup>th</sup> Street). The project will:

- 1. Add sixty ornamental pedestrian streetlights
- 2. Replace sixty trolley pole streetlights
- 3. Remove the overhead streetlight wires and replace them with underground wiring to accommodate the new pedestrian street lighting.

This project is funded by the Redevelopment Agency (ORA), and will utilize a mix of outside contract labor and in-house labor to do the work. The City has procured the streetlights materials. The contractor will build the substructure and City staff will install the new streetlights.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

The engineer's estimate for the construction work is \$720,000.00. The responsive low bidder, Ray's Electric, Inc., submitted a bid of \$617,502.00. The project budget can cover this bid price and provide a contingency of 9%.

Funding for the San Pablo Pedestrian Streetlights project was approved and adopted in the FY 2007-09 Redevelopment Agency and City Policy Budget. Funds for this project were budgeted to the Oakland Redevelopment Agency Projects Fund (7780),

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Capital Projects – Electrical Projects Org. (92228), San Pablo Pedestrian Streetlights Project (C315010) in the amount of \$1,500,000.00.

Details of the project fund are tabulated in *Attachment A*.

The funds appropriated for the Public Works Agency Department of Infrastructure and Operations Electrical Services to execute the project cover the cost of electricity for ten years, after which, costs may be charged to the Landscape and Lighting Assessment District or other available funds.

#### **BACKGROUND**

The San Pablo Pedestrian Streetlights Project consists of building a substructure on San Pablo Avenue for installing ornamental pedestrian streetlights. The project includes: streetlight foundation, trenches for streetlight wiring, installation of Tesco panels to supply power to the new ornamental pedestrian streetlights, restoration of streets, sidewalks, curb and gutter, and ramps; and other related work indicated on the plans and specifications.

On February 26, 2009, the City Clerk received seven bids for the project. The bids ranged from \$524,182.00 to \$1,107,278.00. Ray's Electric, Inc's responsive low bid of \$617,502.00 met all contract requirements. A Summary of the Bids Received is shown on *Attachment B*.

Contract Compliance has evaluated the bid results and verified the DBE information. A summary of its analysis report is shown in *Attachment D*.

#### **KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS**

The project location is on a state highway in Oakland and lies between the neighboring cities of Emeryville and Berkeley. Street lighting is distinctive in each of the adjacent cities: Oakland has traditional cobra head streetlights; Emeryville has ornamental streetlights; and Berkeley has brighter cobra head streetlights. This project adds ornamental pedestrian streetlights that harmonize with the street lighting schemes in the neighboring communities. The aesthetically pleasing ornamental pedestrian street lighting would increase the level of safety lighting on the sidewalk. The project is located in Council District 1.

Construction work is anticipated to begin in July 22, 2009, weather permitting, and will be completed by April 28, 2010. The contract specifies \$500.00 in liquidated damages per calendar day if the contract completion time of 150 working days is exceeded. The project schedule is shown on *Attachment C*.

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#### **EVALUATION OF PERFORMANCE**

The City has evaluated Ray's Electric, Inc., performance on a previous City project completed in 2008. Ray's Electric performance was rated "average" in that evaluation.

#### SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

<u>Economic</u>: All public works contracts require prevailing rate of wages. Prevailing wages offer a livable wage for workers and contribute to an improved quality of life.

<u>Environmental</u>: Materials will be sent to recycling facilities to the extent possible. In addition, the improved lighting in sidewalk surface will make walking, parking, and bicycling easier and thus encourage residents to walk and use bicycles more and drive less, thereby helping to reduce air pollution and traffic congestion.

<u>Social Equity</u>: Pedestrian streetlights work to enhance the City's infrastructure, beautify public access and assure the public with a sense of security. The pedestrian streetlights ensure that street rehabilitation funds are spent in a manner that is equitable throughout the city.

#### DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

Pedestrian streetlights illuminate the sidewalk better and provide brighter lighting of the pavements, tree wells, fire hydrants, traffic signal poles and street furniture. The disabled and senior citizens can better see the sidewalk pavement and would feel more secure in their activities in this segment of San Pablo Avenue.

#### RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

Staff recommends the award of a construction contract to Ray's Electric, Inc., in the amount of \$617,502.00 for the San Pablo Pedestrian Streetlights Project (Project No. C315010). Ray's Electric, Inc., has met the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise goals, and there are sufficient funds in the project accounts to cover this contract.

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#### **ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL**

Staff recommends that the City Council approve the resolution.

Arthulia failed to meet the City's 20% trucking requirement. Staff was unable to determine compliance for Hudson Excavation because the firm listed hourly rates instead of total subcontract dollars.
