RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000) FOR OUTCOME AND PROCESS EVALUATION SERVICES OF THE MEASURE Y VIOLENCE PREVENTION PROGRAMMING, FY 2008-2009, JULY 1 2008 – JUNE 30, 2009.

WHEREAS, City of Oakland voters passed Measure Y – the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 – to provide tax revenue each year for ten years to support violence prevention and public safety programs and services in Oakland's neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 stipulates that not less than 1% or more than 3% of funds appropriated to any police service or social service program shall be set aside for the purpose of an annual independent evaluation of the program, including the number of people served and the rate of crime or violence reduction achieved; and

WHEREAS, City staff developed and disseminated a Request for Proposals in April 2008 and conducted a proposal review and selection process to identify a contractor to provide evaluation services; and

WHEREAS, the selected contractor, Resource Development Associates was ranked first in the competitive bidding process;

WHEREAS, an annual comprehensive outcome evaluation of Measure Y violence prevention and community policing programs is mandated by the Measure Y Initiative; and

WHEREAS, due to Resource Development Associates clear understanding of Measure Y programs and strategies, its breadth of experience, range of content knowledge and technical capacity, RDA can provide an outcome evaluation prior to the completion of the FY 2009-2010 budget process; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator wishes to enter into a one-year contractual agreement (with two one-year options to renew) with Resource Development Associates to provide (1) an outcome and process evaluation of the Measure Y violence prevention programs and (2) an End of Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Report on Measure Y Community Policing and Violence Prevention Programs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the service is of a professional, scientific or technical nature and is temporary in nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive service; and

WHEREAS, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004 stipulates the community policing and violence prevention programs shall be evaluated annually; and

WHEREAS, the current contract for evaluation services between the City of Oakland and Berkeley Policy Associates ended in June 2008; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the funds will be made available for (1) an outcome and process evaluation of Measure Y Violence Prevention Programs and (2) completion of the End of Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Report on Measure Y Violence Prevention Programs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with Resource Development Associates in an amount not to exceed (three hundred fifty thousand dollars) \$350,000 (Measure Y Evaluation Project (G261240), FY 2008-2009) to (1) conduct an outcome and process evaluation of the Measure Y Violence Prevention Programs and (2) provide an End of Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Report on the Measure Y Community Policing and Violence Prevention Programs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including, but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests and related

actions which may be necessary in accordance with its basic purpose, at no additional contract costs; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute the two contract options to renew with Resource Development Associates without further City Council review; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreements shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
