RESOLUTION No. 80575 C.M.S.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF OAKLAND AND VOLUNTEERS OF AMERICA, BAY AREA, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$78,000 TO PROVIDE PROJECT CHOICE REENTRY HOUSING ASSISTANCE FOR THE PERIOD OF MAY 1, 2007 TO DECEMBER 31, 2007

WHEREAS, City of Oakland voters passed Measure Y, the Violence Prevention and Public Safety Act of 2004, in November 2004, approving a series of taxes to support violence prevention programs including the Project Choice program for parolees; and

WHEREAS, through a competitive Request for Proposals process Volunteers of America, Bay Area, Inc. was the most qualified and competent entity to implement Project Choice intensive case management; and

WHEREAS, through a grant to the Project Choice program from the Community Action Partnership, additional funding is available to support housing for parolees served through Project Choice; and

WHEREAS, the funding for this agreement is allocated to State of California Y Fund (2159), DHS Administration Unit Organization (78111), CAP/CSBG 2006 Project (G265010) and CAP/CSBG 2007 Project (G265020), Fostering Safe and Health Program (SC22); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into an agreement with Volunteers of America, Bay Area, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$78,000 to implement this program; and now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Volunteers of America, Bay Area, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$78,000, for the purpose of providing Project Choice housing support for reentering offenders for the period of May 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, amendments, modifications, payment requests and related actions which may be necessary in accordance with its basic purpose; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreements shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.


