Paula Hawthorn and her husband, Michael Ubell, bought their home in the Rockridge area of Oakland in 1992, and continue to live in that house. In Paula's professional career she was usually the vice president of software engineering for start-up companies (see attached resume for list). Now retired, Paula is volunteering with various Oakland gun violence prevention groups: Oakland/Alameda County Brady Campaign to Prevent Gun Violence (to help stop the flow of guns into our city); S.A.V.E. Center for Community Change and Empowerment (to help change the gun culture); Make Oakland Better Now! (to support Cease Fire, the effective homicide reduction program); the Coalition for Police Accountability (to increase the earned trust in the police, an important part of gun violence prevention); and, the Violence Prevention Coalition (working to overcome the root causes of gun violence). Paula has organized the Oakland Gun Tracing Group (Youth Alive!, SAVE, Brady, Giffords, and Moms Demand Action) who meet with OPD – usually the head of the CID – to discuss progress on gun tracing.

Paula's husband Michael is the Chair of the Greater Rockridge NCPC and when Kales Ave had a minor crime spree a Neighborhood Watch was formed which Paula was the chair of.

Paula is comfortable working with the police and with the community. Thank you for your consideration for Paula as the District 1 representative for the CPAB.

INTRODUCED BY MAYOR LIBBY SCHAAF

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF DONALD DAHLKE AND PAULA HAWTHORN AS MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY POLICING ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 72727 C.M.S., adopted June 11, 1996 and amended by Resolution No. 73916 C.M.S., adopted November 4, 1997, which changed the body's status from a Task Force to a Board, establishes that the Community Policing Advisory Board shall oversee, monitor and report at least twice yearly and provide recommendations on community policing to the Mayor, City Council, City Manager, and director of Police Services; and

WHEREAS, the Community Policing Advisory Board consists of fifteen (15) members, all Oakland residents, serving three-year terms, three appointed by the Mayor, one by each Councilmember, one by the Oakland Housing Authority, one by the Oakland Unified School District Board, and two by the Home Alert Steering Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed **Donald Dahlke and Paula Hawthorn** to serve a three-year term, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of:

Donald Dahlke to the Community Policing Advisory Board to serve a three-year term, as the District 6 Representative, that began March 25, 2017 and ends March 24, 2020, filling the seat previously held by Colleen Brown.

Paula Hawthorn to the Community Policing Advisory Board to serve a three-year term, as the District 1 Representative, that began March 25, 2017 and ends March 24, 2020, filling the seat previously held by Cathy Leonard.
