FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of One Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$175,000.00) be payable to Plaintiff Douglas Laughlin and Charles F. Bourdon, his attorney of record.
