

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ASSEMBLY BILL ("AB") 231, AB 232, AND ABX 11, PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO REFORM THE CALIFORNIA ENTERPRISE ZONE PROGRAM.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Oakland supports AB 231, AB 232, and ABX 11, proposed amendments intended to strengthen the Enterprise Zone Program, making it more accountable to the public and to the Oakland community; and


