RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GEZ ARCHITECTS AND ENGINEERS IN AN AMOUNT, WITH CONTINGENCY, NOT TO EXCEED THIRTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED NINE DOLLARS (\$36,509) TO DESIGN AND PROVIDE POST-DESIGN CONSTRUCTION ADMINISTRATION OF AN APPROVED DUST COLLECTION SYSTEM IN THE MUSEUM SERVICES DEPARTMENT'S WOODSHOP

WHEREAS, the Museum Services Department is in need of an airborne dust collection system in its woodshop; and

WHEREAS, there is urgency in providing a safe working environment for employees and CalOSHA has determined that airborne dust in the workshop exceeds acceptable standards and has issued a citation and proposed fines; and

WHEREAS, only one engineering firm in the region has been identified that has the technical and practical expertise to design the workshop dust collection system given the special requirements of the museum space and regulatory environment in which the design must be developed;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this contract is for services of a professional nature and will be temporary; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that the City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a professional services agreement with GEZ architects and engineers on a time-and-materials basis in an amount, including a ten percent (10%) contingency, not to exceed \$36,509 to design a dust control system for the Museum Services Department and to provide post-design construction management services; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the agreement shall be reviewed and approved by the City Attorney for form and legality and a copy filed with the City Clerk.
