WHEREAS, this month, in a statewide effort observing Arts Education Month, California counties, school districts, schools, museums, performing arts centers, libraries and government buildings host events that illustrate the importance and lifelong benefits of arts education; therefore be it

RESOLVED: that the City of Oakland places its focus on youth art education in the month of March, celebrating Art IS Education, and communicating the value of the arts for all students, to foster cross-cultural understanding, to give recognition to our city's outstanding young artists, to focus on careers in the arts available to Alameda County students and to enhance public and educational support for this essential part of school curriculum.
