RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to settle the claim of Edward Rinne, our file C29970, for the sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$14,520.00) payable to Edward Rinne, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Dollars and No Cents (\$14,520.00) be made payable to Edward Rinne.
