RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$15,000) ANNUALLY FOR THREE YEARS FROM THE PORT OF OAKLAND, BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS, TO REIMBURSE THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR FUEL AND MAINTENANCE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH USE OF MARINE PATROL VESSELS BY THE MARINE UNIT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AND PORT SECURITY OF OAKLAND WATERWAYS, AND AUTHORIZING THE DEPARTMENT TO ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE PORT OF OAKLAND FROM JANUARY 1, 2011 TO DECEMBER, 31 2013 FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Marine Unit of the Oakland Police Department is the City’s designated regulator of waterway security in and around the City of Oakland including the Estuary and Oakland International Airport waterside; and

WHEREAS, members of the Marine Unit currently patrol City of Oakland waterways with two small boats that require maintenance of both vessels and engines; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Oakland will reimburse the City of Oakland up to \$15,000 annually throughout the term of the agreement for the cost of fuel and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council previously authorized acceptance of similar funds by Resolution No. 79374 C.M.S., dated July 19, 2005; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator or his designee to accept and appropriate funds in the amount of \$15,000 annually for three years from the Port of Oakland, Board of Port Commissioners, to reimburse the Oakland Police Department for fuel and maintenance costs associated with use of the marine patrol vessels by the Marine Unit for law enforcement and Port security of Oakland waterways: and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Port of Oakland for the period January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013, for implementation of this agreement; and be it

FUTHER RESOLVED: That said funds associated with this project shall be maintained in the State of California Grant Fund: 2999; Special Operations Division Org.: 105610; Marine Unit Program: PS13; in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator or his designee as agent of the City to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the fuel, and maintenance reimbursement memorandum of understanding.


