

RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO IDENTIFY AND ALLOCATE FUNDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF 64TH AVENUE AND FOOTHILL BOULEVARD

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2009, staff presented to the Public Works Committee three City and Agency resolutions to award a construction contract for the Construction of 66th Avenue Street Improvement Project from San Leandro Street to International Boulevard (City Project No. P318410); and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Committee directed staff to identify and allocate funding for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of 64th Avenue and Foothill Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, staff is already working expeditiously to design pedestrian and safety improvements at this intersection; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council directs staff to identify and allocate funding for the construction of a traffic signal at the intersection of 64th Avenue and Foothill Boulevard; and return to the Council with a report on funding of the requested traffic signal improvement on December 8, 2009.


