RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION TO THE ALAMEDA COUNTY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY FOR GRANT FUNDS FROM THE MEASURE B BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN COUNTYWIDE DISCRETION FUND FOR PLANNING AND FEASIBILITY STUDIES FOR INTERMODAL STREETSCAPE IMPROVEMENTS ON TELEGRAPH AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency formed the Broadway/MacArthur/San Pablo Redevelopment Project Area in June 2000; and

WHEREAS, the five year implementation plan for the Broadway/MacArthur/San Pablo Redevelopment Project Area includes streetscape improvements on Telegraph Avenue as a priority project; and

WHEREAS, the streetscape improvements on Telegraph Avenue will need to incorporate access for bicycles, pedestrians, automobiles, and an AC Transit bus rapid transit route; and

WHEREAS, the Alameda County Transportation Improvement Authority has released a call for projects for the Measure B Bicycle and Pedestrian Countywide Discretionary Fund to request applications for grant funding; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the Agency Administrator is authorized to apply for funding from the Measure B Bicycle and Pedestrian Countywide Discretionary Fund to pay for design work and feasibility and planning studies that coordinate proposed pedestrian, bicycle, automobile, and bus rapid transit improvements on Telegraph Avenue; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agency has independently reviewed and considered this environmental determination, and the Agency finds and determines that this action complies with CEQA because this action on the part of the Agency is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15262 (feasibility and planning studies) of the CEQA guidelines; and be it
