RE: **Resolutions Authorizing Seven (7) Professional Services Agreements For As-Needed Geotechnical Engineering Services With Ninyo & Moore, Cal Engineering & Geology, Inc., Furgo West, Inc., Kleinfelder, Inc., ASG, Inc., Mactec Engineering and Consulting, Inc., and Engeo, Inc., For A Contract Amount Not To Exceed Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) Each**

SUMMARY

Resolutions have been prepared authorizing the City Administrator, or her designee, to enter into professional agreements to provide as-needed geotechnical engineering services with each of the following seven local firms: 1) Ninyo & Moore, 2) Cal Engineering & Geology, Inc., 3) Furgo West, Inc., 4) Kleinfelder, Inc., 5) ASG, Inc., 6) Mactec Engineering and Consulting, Inc., and 7) Engeo, Inc. Each professional services agreement is for a not to exceed amount of \$350,000.00 over a three-year period.

The as-needed geotechnical engineering services are required for projects involving field investigations, landslides, retaining walls, building foundations, groundwater issues, pavement failures, and other work as requested by the City. The seven (7) as-needed geotechnical services consultants also have the ability to respond in a timely manner to various emergency projects throughout the year that require an immediate response to mitigate potentially dangerous situations and/or extensive loss of property.

The as-needed geotechnical engineering services for various projects are consistent with the Mayoral and Council Citywide Objective to "Build and Foster Livable Neighborhoods" by building and maintaining the City facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT

Each agreement is for an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00 or a total of \$2,450,000.00 for all seven (7) contracts. The services will be provided through individual projects funded by various sources. The approval of these contracts will not result in the additional appropriation of funds. Funding will be identified prior to the performance of the geotechnical engineering services.

BACKGROUND

In June 2006, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for as-needed geotechnical engineering services. Seven (7) firms responded to the RFP. The proposal evaluation panel consisted of a Civil Engineer from the Public Works Agency and a Civil Engineer from The East Bay Municipal Utility District. All seven (7) geotechnical engineering consultant firms were determined to be competent and fully capable of providing geotechnical services for the City. The evaluation criteria included the following:

1. Relevant experience;
2. Team and staff qualifications;
3. Organization of firm, availability of resources and capability to meet project schedules;
4. Understanding of the nature of work and awareness of potential problems and solutions; and
5. Overall quality and clarity of the proposals.

The seven firms are as follows: 1) Ninyo & Moore, 2) Cal Engineering & Geology, Inc., 3) Furgo West, Inc., 4) Kleinfelder, Inc., 5) ASG, Inc., 6) Mactec Engineering and Consulting, Inc., and 7) Engeo, Inc., are recommended to be awarded a contract. Six of the seven firms are certified local businesses and the seventh firm recently established a local office.

Each of the firms has met the Local/Small Business Enterprise requirements. This information has been verified by the Contract Compliance Division of the City Administrator's Office and is shown in Attachment A. As the specific scope of work of the additional geotechnical services is developed, the consultant will utilize small local sub-consultants to the extent feasible. LBE and SLBE participation levels noted in Attachment A will be maintained throughout the contract.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The as-needed geotechnical engineering consultants are required to provide geotechnical studies, engineering analysis, site evaluations, subsurface investigations, and specialized laboratory testing for various types of projects which involve soil mechanics, groundwater issues, pavement failure/rehabilitation, and/or trench excavations, and other work as requested by the City.

It is anticipated that several future CIP projects funded by various sources will utilize the as-needed geotechnical services agreements. As-needed geotechnical engineering services agreements allow the City to promptly respond to and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner. The agreements will also reduce the time and costs associated with selecting consultants compared to an individual project-by-project request for proposals process.

SUSTAINABLE OPPORTUNITIES

Economic: The projects will generate jobs for Oakland residents, and business tax, sales tax and other revenues for the City by those who work on the project.

Environmental: Environmental factors and opportunities will be considered and incorporated to the extent feasible. Consultants will be required to consider the use of recycled materials in the products specified and to explore other environmental opportunities such as reducing waste and conserving energy.

Social Equity: There are no direct social equity issues related to these agreements.

DISABILITY AND SENIOR CITIZEN ACCESS

Where applicable in geotechnical engineering projects, consultants will be required to design the City projects in compliance with the physical access requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

RECOMMENDATION AND RATIONALE

As-needed agreements with geotechnical engineering firms are necessary to evaluate and resolve geotechnical related issues in a quick and efficient manner. These agreements will expedite the design of capital improvement projects and the resolution of emergency projects. They will also reduce staff time and costs associated with selecting consultants on a project-by-project basis.

It is recommended to award the professional services agreements for: 1) Ninyo & Moore, 2) Cal Engineering & Geology, Inc., 3) Furgo West, Inc., 4) Kleinfelder, Inc., 5) ASG, Inc., 6) Mactec Engineering and Consulting, Inc., and 7) Engeo, Inc. Each contract is for an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00.

ACTION REQUESTED OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends that City Council approve the resolutions authorizing the City Administrator, or her designee, to enter into professional service agreements with the seven (7) geotechnical engineering firms.







INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER _____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH NINYO & MOORE FOR AS-NEEDED GEOTECHNICAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR A CONTRACT AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000.00)

WHEREAS, professional geotechnical engineering services are needed to provide geotechnical studies, engineering analysis, site evaluations, subsurface investigations, and specialized laboratory testing for various types of projects which involve landslides, soil mechanics, groundwater issues, pavement failure/rehabilitation, and/or trench excavations, and other work as requested by the City; and

WHEREAS, as-needed geotechnical engineering services agreements allow the City to promptly respond and provide the necessary services in an efficient and timely manner; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that several future CIP projects funded by various sources will utilize the as-needed services agreements; and

WHEREAS, emergency projects may occur that will likely also require geotechnical engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the geotechnical engineering services will be funded through the various individual projects, and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the services; and

WHEREAS, seven firms responded to the City's Request for Proposals and Ninyo & Moore was chosen as one of the firms that have the necessary qualifications and experience required to provide the services; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to enter into a contract with Ninyo & Moore and the City Council finds that this contract is for services of a professional nature; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the professional geotechnical services are exempt from competitive bidding pursuant to Section 2.04.05 of the Oakland Municipal Code; and


