RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO COMPROMISE AND SETTLE THE CASE OF KAYVAN SABEGHI v. OAKLAND POLICE OFFICER FRANK UU, UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT CASE NO. C12-06057 JCS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$645,000.00 AS A RESULT OF A CONFRONTATION WITH POLICE AT 17TH AND BROADWAY (OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT – EXCESS FORCE/CIVIL RIGHTS)

WHEREAS: Kayvan Sabeghi was injured when he was struck by an Oakland police officer near 17th and Broadway, and

WHEREAS: Mr Sabeghi sustained serious injuries requiring medical treatment as a result of this accident, and

WHEREAS: In order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury verdict under the circumstances, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is authorized and directed to compromise and settle the case of Kayvan Sabeghi v Oakland Police Officer Frank Uu, et al, City Attorney's File No X03871, for the sum of Six Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$645,000 00), and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney is further authorized and directed to take whatever steps as may be necessary to effect said settlement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the sum of Six Hundred Forty-Five Thousand Dollars and No Cents (\$645,000 00) be payable to Plaintiff Kayvan Sabeghi and his attorney Rachel Lederman


