Pursuant to Section 401 of the Charter, the City Attorney has prepared and requests your approval of a resolution authorizing compromise and settlement of the above-entitled claim for the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$60,000.00), payable to Akilah Mwamba Blakwomyn.

This action arises out of a trip and fall allegedly caused by a dangerous condition of public property on May 4, 2016, in front of the building located at 1950 Franklin Street.

The Council authorized settlement of this case in Closed Session on Tuesday, April 17, 2018 (moved by Councilmember Dan Kalb and seconded by Councilmember Lynette Gibson McElhaney - 6 Ayes, 2 Absent – Councilmember Desley Brooks and Council President Larry Reid).
