RESOLUTION No. 83412 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF DERRICK H. MUHAMMAD AND ELIZABETH DIAZ TO THE CITIZEN'S POLICE REVIEW BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 12454 C.M.S., adopted November 12, 2002 (repealing Ordinance Nos. 11905 and 12102 C.M.S.) created the Oakland Citizen's Police Review Board to investigate and review certain complaints regarding conduct of Oakland police officers and park rangers, thereafter deliver timely advisory reports to the City Administrator regarding the facts of and recommended disposition of these complaints, as well as disciplinary recommendations if appropriate and additionally it may recommend policy changes to the Public Safety Committee regarding matters within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, the Citizen's Police Review Board consists of nine members and three alternative members serving two-year staggered terms with no more than two consecutive terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Jean Quan has appointed Derrick H. Muhammad and Elizabeth Diaz to serve two-year terms on the Citizen's Police Review Board subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Derrick H. Muhammad and Elizabeth Diaz to serve two-year terms on the Citizen's Police Review Board; Muhammad beginning February 16, 2011 and ending February 15, 2013, filling

the seat previously held by Carl Swanson and Diaz beginning February 16, 2011 and ending February 15, 2013, filling the seat she previously held.


