

Resolution No. 2008-0098 C.M.S.

AN AGENCY RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2008-2013 IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE WEST OAKLAND REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, Section 33490 of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.) requires a redevelopment agency to adopt an implementation plan every five years; and

WHEREAS, the Agency Administrator has prepared and presented to the Agency an Implementation Plan for the West Oakland Redevelopment Project for 2008-2013; and

WHEREAS, the Agency held a public hearing on November 18, 2008 to receive comment on the proposed Implementation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Implementation Plan as presented to the Agency sets forth the specific goals and objectives for the West Oakland Project Area, the specific programs, projects and estimated expenditures over the next five years, and an explanation of how the goals, objectives, programs, projects, and expenditures will eliminate blight within the Project Area and meet low-and moderate-income housing requirements, as required by law; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Agency hereby approves and adopts the 2008-2013 Implementation Plan for the West Oakland Redevelopment Project attached to the staff report as Attachment A; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Agency Administrator or his designee is hereby authorized to take whatever action is appropriate with respect to the Implementation Plan consistent with this Resolution and its basic purposes.
