RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 236S FOR DEVELOPED SUBDIVISIONS WITH COMPLETED UNDERGROUND UTILITY SERVICE AT ARIANE COURT, A SEGMENT OF DIABLO DRIVE, BISHOPS COURT, OBSERVATION PLACE, SKYLINE CIRCLE AND A SEGMENT OF REDWOOD ROAD, PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 7769 C.M.S., AND TO SET A PUBLIC HEARING FOR NOVEMBER 16, 2004.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 7769 C.M.S. establishes a procedure for the creation of Underground Utility Districts and requires as the initial step in such procedure the holding of a public hearing to ascertain whether public necessity, health, safety or welfare requires the removal of poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication or similar associated service in any such district; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That Tuesday, the 16th day of November, 2004, at 7:00 p.m. in the regular meeting place of this City Council, Council Chambers, City Hall, One Frank H. Ogawa Plaza, Oakland, California, be, and the same are appointed and fixed as the time and place of public hearing when and where this Council will allow public testimony regarding the proposed Underground Utility District No. 236S; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Clerk shall notify or cause to notify all affected property owners as shown on the last equalized assessment roll and utilities concerned of the time and place of such hearing by mailing a copy of this resolution together with an explanatory letter to such property owners and utilities concerned at least ten (10) days prior to the date thereof. Hearing notices shall also be publicly posted within the area of the proposed district; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the area proposed to be included in said District No. 236S is shown in exhibits A, B, C, D, E and F attached hereto; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the purpose for the creation of the Underground Utility District is to assure that no future overhead facilities can be placed within the designated subdivisions.
