INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER _____

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR DESIGNEE TO ENTER INTO ON-CALL SANITARY SEWERS PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENTS, EACH FOR A DURATION OF FIVE YEARS WITH THE FOLLOWING FIRMS:

A) TIER-ONE FIRMS EACH FOR AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED THREE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$350,000.00) WITH: 1) SCHAAF & WHEELER CONSULTANT ENGINEERS, 2) NBA ENGINEERING, INC., AND 3) BLACK & VEATCH CORPORATION;

B) TIER-TWO FIRMS EACH FOR AN AMOUNT NOT-TO-EXCEED EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$850,000.00) WITH: 1) BKF ENGINEERS, AND 2) WOOD ROGERS, INC.

WHEREAS, the professional services agreements are needed to provide on-call sanitary sewers professional engineering services to assist Oakland Public Works with technical, design, and engineering services to support the delivery of projects; and

WHEREAS, the City's current staffing capacity is insufficient to deliver much needed technical, design, and engineering services; and

WHEREAS, in March, 2020, the City issued a Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Sanitary Sewers Professional Engineering Services and six (6) firms submitted Statements of Qualifications (SOQ); and

WHEREAS, the six (6) firms were evaluated by staff with experience in the scope of services and project types identified in the RFQ; and

WHEREAS, Department of Workplace and Employment Standards' Contract Compliance analysis was completed on May 5, 2020 to the Request for Qualifications and revised on August 3, 2020; and

WHEREAS, one (1) firm did not meet the City (LBE/SLBE) requirement and was deemed non-responsive; and

WHEREAS, based on staff's evaluation, contract requirements, and assessment of Division needs, five (5) firms have been selected for recommendation to be awarded with professional services agreement to provide on-call sanitary sewers professional engineering services; and

WHEREAS, on-call sanitary sewers professional engineering services will be funded through various individual projects and funds will be identified prior to the performance of the on-call services; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the agreements shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive services; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council adopt a resolution authorizing the City Administrator or designee to enter into on-call sanitary sewers professional engineering services agreements:

A) Tier-One Firms Each For An Amount Not-To-Exceed Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$350,000.00) With: 1) Schaaf & Wheeler Consultant Engineers, 2) NBA Engineering, Inc., and 3) Black & Veatch Corporation;

B) Tier-Two Firms Each For An Amount Not-To-Exceed Eight Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$850,000.00) With: 1) BKF Engineers, and 2) Wood Rogers; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the terms of each agreement shall be executed for five (5) years duration; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to approve any subsequent amendments to or extensions of said agreement with the exception of those related to an increase in total compensation, provided that such amendments or extensions shall be filed with the City Clerk's Office; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That a copy of the Agreement will be on file in the City Clerk's Office and will be approved for form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney.
