RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE ALAMEDA COUNTY CONGESTION MANAGEMENT AGENCY (ACCMA) AS THE LEAD PROJECT SPONSOR AND IMPLEMENTING AGENCY FOR THE INTERSTATE-880 NORTH SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, WITH OAKLAND'S COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS AN ACTIVE PARTNER THAT ACCMA WILL CONSULT AND INCLUDE IN ALL MATERIAL DISCUSSIONS.

WHEREAS, Regional Measure 2 (a.k.a. RM 2), approved by voters in March 2004, designates at least \$10 million for the "I-880 North Safety Improvement Project"

WHEREAS, this I-880 North Safety Improvement Project will include numerous safety improvements to enhance the quality of life of low-income residents in Oakland's Jingletown neighborhood adjacent to I-880 such as a soundwall adjacent to Oakland's Jingletown neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, this application is strongly supported by the residents in the Jingletown neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) is responsible for funding projects eligible for RM 2 funds, pursuant to the State of California Streets and Highways Code Section 30914(c) and (d); and

WHEREAS, MTC has established a process whereby eligible transportation project sponsors may submit allocation requests for RM 2 funding; and

WHEREAS, allocation requests to MTC must be submitted consistent with procedures and conditions as outlined in Regional Measure 2 Policy and Procedures; and

WHEREAS, MTC requires that co-sponsors of any project identify a single lead agency prior to receiving funds;

WHEREAS, Alameda County Congestion Management Agency (ACCMA), City of Oakland, and the California Department of Transportation are joint sponsors of the I-880 North Safety Improvement project; and

WHEREAS, ACCMA, City of Oakland, and the California Department of Transportation have identified the ACCMA as the lead agency for the I-880 North Safety Improvement project; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Oakland City Council designates the ACCMA as the lead project sponsor and implementing agency for the I-880 North Safety Improvement Project, with Oakland's Community and Economic Development Agency as an active partner that ACCMA will consult and include in all material discussions; and

RESOLVED, that the Oakland City Administrator is hereby authorized to sign a Memorandum of Understanding with MTC, if necessary, to enable this project to proceed.
