A Report And Proposed Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator, On Behalf Of The City Of Oakland, To Enter Into An Agreement With The California Commission On Peace Officer Standards And Training (POST) For The Purpose Of Permitting The Police Department To Present The POST Certified Academy Recruit Training Officer Course Up To Three Times Throughout The Course Of The Agreement To 72 Students, And To Receive Up To Nine Thousand Three Hundred And Seven Dollars And

Ninety Eight Cents (\$9,307.98) In Reimbursement Funds

SUMMARY

A resolution has been prepared authorizing the City Administrator to execute an agreement with the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) for the purpose of permitting the Police Department to present the POST certified Academy Recruit Training Officer (RTO) Course up to three times during the term of the contract and receive reimbursement funds up to \$9,307.98. The term of the agreement with POST for presentation of the Academy Recruit Training Officer Course is July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007.

FISCAL IMPACT

The \$9,307.98 covers the full cost of up to three course presentations, up to 72 students, throughout the one-year agreement. Reimbursement funds shall be deposited in General Purpose Fund: 1010, in OPD Training Org. code: 103430, in Training Program PS09.

BACKGROUND

The Police Department routinely conducts POST certified training courses for the benefit of Oakland police officers and police officers from other law enforcement agencies. The City of Oakland has been coordinating the Academy Recruit Training Officer Course for POST since 1991.

KEY ISSUES AND IMPACTS

The requirements for the Academy Recruit Training Officer Course are specified by POST and include foundational information about basic academy training and POST laws and regulations.

All Academy Recruit Training Officers throughout the state must attend the course within one year of appointment to the position. The City of Oakland is the sole presenter of the course for the State of California.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF OAKLAND, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA COMMISSION ON PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND TRAINING (POST) FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PRESENT THE POST CERTIFIED ACADEMY RECRUIT TRAINING OFFICER COURSE UP TO THREE TIMES THROUGHOUT THE COURSE OF THE AGREEMENT TO 72 STUDENTS, AND TO RECEIVE UP TO NINE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND SEVEN DOLLARS AND NINETY EIGHT CENTS (\$9,307.98) IN REIMBURSEMENT FUNDS

WHEREAS, the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) has requested that the City of Oakland Police Department present the POST certified Academy Recruit Training Officer Course to California Law Enforcement personnel who are appointed to the position of Academy Recruit Training Officer; and

WHEREAS, POST will reimburse the Police Department for up to three presentations of the Recruit Training Officer Course, not to exceed 72 total students, up to a maximum amount of \$9,307.98, during the period of July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Oakland to execute an agreement with POST for the purposes described above; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has executed similar agreements with POST and has been the sole presenter of the Recruit Training Officer Course for the State of California since 1991; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designees is to submit and execute an agreement between the City of Oakland and POST for the purposes described above; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator as agent of the City to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the contract.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve any agreements authorized hereunder for form and legality, and copies of any fully executed agreements authorized hereunder shall be placed on file with the Office of the City Clerk.

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the money shall be appropriated to the Police Department General Purpose Fund (1010), Training Organization Code (103430), Training Program Code (PS09).
