RESOLUTION APPOINTING CITY ADMINISTRATOR ED REISKIN TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE YOUTH VENTURES JOINT POWERS AUTHORITY TO REPLACE AND COMPLETE THE TERM OF CHIEF OF POLICE LERONNE ARMSTRONG

WHEREAS, on July 25, 2006 the Oakland City Council approved the Joint Powers Authority ("JPA") creating the Youth Ventures Joint Powers Authority; and

WHEREAS, the JPA Agreement provides that the City Council may make five appointments to the Youth Ventures JPA Board of Trustees for terms of up to four years; and

WHEREAS, Section VI.A.4 of the JPA Agreement states that trustee terms shall be for 4 years, subject to replacement at any time by the appointing authority; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Rules of Procedures provide that "the President of the Council shall recommend appointments to regional and local boards and agencies, as appropriate, subject to confirmation by the Council"; and

WHEREAS, Council President Nikki Fortunato Bas recommends that City Administrator Ed Reiskin be appointed to the Youth Ventures Joint Powers Authority Board of Trustees to replace Chief of Police Leronne Armstrong and official alternate Assistant Chief of Police Darren Allison and complete the remainder of the term; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That City Administrator Ed Reiskin is hereby appointed to the Youth Ventures Joint Powers Authority Board of Trustees to replace Chief of Police Leronne Armstrong and complete the remainder of the four-year term commencing on March 2, 2021 and ending March 1, 2025.
