A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE A CONTRIBUTION OF REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FUNDS UNDER THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000 TO ABATE BLIGHT AT ILLEGAL ENCAMPMENT AND DUMPING SITES IN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREAS AND TO FUND WORK BY THE PUBLIC WORKS AGENCY TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO DETER ILLEGAL USES OF THE SITES

WHEREAS, blight conditions consisting of litter and debris at sites used for illegal encampment and illegal dumping are nuisances and health hazards for residents of Oakland's redevelopment areas; and

WHEREAS, blight conditions of litter and debris at sites of illegal encampment and dumping impede economic development by hindering business retention and attraction; and

WHEREAS, one of the primary goals of redevelopment projects in the City of Oakland is the elimination of blighting influences and the correction of environmental deficiencies in the project areas; and

WHEREAS, improvements such as fencing and signage will discourage illegal encampment and dumping; and

WHEREAS, it is a goal of the redevelopment projects in the City of Oakland to strengthen the economic base of the project areas and the community by the installation of needed site improvements to stimulate employment and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, the City and the Redevelopment Agency entered into a Cooperation Agreement on July 1, 2004, which generally governs the provision of assistance and the payment of funds between the two agencies; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City to accept and appropriate a contribution of Redevelopment Agency funds under the Cooperation Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$75,000 to abate blight at illegal encampment and dumping sites in redevelopment project areas and to fund work by the Public Works Agency to make improvements to deter

illegal uses of the sites; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That these funds totaling \$75,000 shall be allocated from Agency funds, organizations and projects and moved to City funds, organizations and projects as detailed in the table below to fund PWA site improvements:
