A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR OR HER DESIGNEE, TO: 1) ENTER INTO A GRANT PROGRAM ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, CORRECTIONS STANDARDS AUTHORITY, FOR JUVENILE ACCOUNTABILITY BLOCK GRANT (JABG) FUNDS; 2) ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND ADMINISTER JABG DIRECT ALLOCATION FUNDS FY 2012-2013 TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$42,227 FOR THE SCHOOL SAFETY POLICING PROJECT FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2012 – JUNE 30, 2013; AND 3) WAIVE THE CENTRAL SERVICES OVERHEAD (CSO) CHARGES OF \$1,541.

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Oakland Police Department will receive State of California, Corrections Standards Authority, Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) funds totaling up to \$42,227 for the OPD School Safety Policing Project from July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, there is a minimum of 10% cash match component required by the grantor for total project expenses in an amount of \$4,692, and this will be drawn from the Oakland Police Department's existing budget; and

WHEREAS, Central Services Overhead (CSO) fees in the amount of \$1,541 should be waived for the expenses funded under this grant to ensure funding is sufficient for grant expenses and to meet the grantor's requirements; and

WHEREAS, the continued partnership between the Oakland Police Department and The Oakland Unified School District will ensure that youth diversion programming that aims to reduce truancy will continue without interruption and evolve based on lessons learned; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to enter into a grant program administration agreement with the State of California, Corrections Standards Authority, for Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) funds for July 1, 2012 through June 30, 2013; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept, and appropriate funds from the State of California, Corrections Standards Authority, Juvenile Accountability Block Fund Direct Appropriation FY 2012-2013 to the Oakland Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$42,227 to be used to pay for costs of the School Safety Policing Project, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That City of Oakland Central Services Overhead fees in the amount of \$1,541 for the FY 2012 – 2013 grant period are hereby waived to ensure availability of grant expenses and to meet grantor guidelines ; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said funds shall be deposited in Fund (2152); Youth and Family Services Division Org. (102350); Youth and Family Services Division Program (PS03), in a Project Account to be determined; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator or her designee is hereby authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept modify, extend and/or amend the agreement, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept and appropriate additional JABG grant funds for youth diversion programming without returning to Council, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Attorney shall review and approve additional fiscal year 2012-2013 JABG as to form and legality and copies of said agreements shall be filed with the Office of the City Clerk.


