

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$140,000) FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, SERVING AS THE FISCAL AGENT FOR PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS AS ADMINISTERED THROUGH THE OFFICE OF THE U.S. ATTORNEY, NORTHERN DISTRICT OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, IN SUPPORT OF THE OAKLAND HOMICIDE TASK FORCE PROGRAM AND THE DRUG EDUCATION FOR YOUTH PROGRAM WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that grant funds in an amount not to exceed one hundred forty thousand dollars (\$140,000) will be received from the State of California, Office of Emergency Services, in support of the Oakland Homicide Task Force Program and the Drug Education for Youth (DEFY) Program within the Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that up to \$100,000 of said funds shall be designated for the Oakland Homicide Task Force Program and \$40,000 shall be designated for the Drug Education for Youth Program; and

**WHEREAS**, these State of California grant funds are to be used to expand law enforcement efforts to address gun violence and narcotics trafficking problems through comprehensive programs within the City of Oakland; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby authorizes the City Administrator or her designee to accept up to \$140,000 in grant funds from the State of California, Office of Emergency Services and appropriate said funds to the Police Department; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the funds for the Oakland Homicide Task Force Program shall be maintained in the State of California, Office of Emergency Services Grant Fund: 2146; Org.: 102250; in a Project Number to be established; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the funds for the Drug Education for Youth (DEFY) Program shall be maintained in the State of California, Office of Emergency Services Grant Fund: 2146; Org.: 104223; in a Project Number to be established; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator or her designee is authorized to complete all required negotiations, certifications, assurances and documentation required to accept, modify, extend and/or amend the grant award; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby appoints the City Administrator as agent of the City to conduct all negotiations, applications, agreements, and related actions which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned grant and funding agreements.
