**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF FEDERAL FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, DRUG ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION (DEA), IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED SEVENTY THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SEVENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND SEVENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$70,578.75) FOR THE OVERTIME REIMBURSEMENT COSTS OF POLICE PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO THE OAKLAND AREA VIOLENT DRUG TASK FORCE, FOR THE PERIOD OF APRIL 1, 2003 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2004, TO THE OAKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Drug Enforcement Administration (hereinafter "DEA") has formed an Oakland Area Violent Drug Task Force to disrupt the illicit drug traffic in the greater Oakland/East Bay area by immobilizing targeted violators and trafficking organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, the Oakland Police Department has agreed to assign four officers and one sergeant to participate in the Oakland Area Violent Drug Task Force; and

**WHEREAS**, the DEA agrees to reimburse the City for overtime costs of the officers assigned to the Task Force up to a maximum of \$14,115.75 per officer for the period from April 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004; and

**WHEREAS**, the DEA will not reimburse the City for any indirect costs related to the performance of overtime service; now, therefore be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Manager or her designee is authorized to accept funds from the Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA), in an amount not to exceed \$70,578.75 and to appropriate said funds to the Police Department for the overtime costs of police personnel assigned to the Oakland Area Violent Drug Task Force for the period from April 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the Central Service Overhead charges (17.7%) of approximately \$12,492.44 are hereby waived; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That said funds shall be appropriated to the Department of Justice Grant Fund 2112, Org. Code: 102277, in a Project number to be assigned.
