RESOLUTION No. 83220 C.M.S.

RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT CHRISTOPHER ANDREWS AS MEMBER OF THE LANDMARKS PRESERVATION ADVISORY BOARD

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 8883 C.M.S., passed October 4, 1973, and amended by Ordinance No. 11776, passed March 14, 1995 establishes the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board to identify historic landmarks in Oakland, conduct design review hearings on historic properties, and advise the City Planning Commission and City Council on preservation; and

WHEREAS, the Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board consists of seven (7) members including one architect, one landscape architect or city planner, one real estate broker with significant experience in historic real estate, and one historian or architectural historian, and two other members, each serving 3-year terms but not more than two consecutive three year terms; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Jean Quan has appointed Christopher Andrews to serve a three year term in the position of architectural historian, subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Christopher Andrews for a three year term beginning February 22, 2011 and ending February 21, 2014 to the

Landmarks Preservation Advisory Board, filling the seat previously held by Kirk Peterson.
