ORDINANCE NO. 12631 C.M.S.

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 12611 C.M.S. (MASTER FEE SCHEDULE) TO INCREASE THE \$30 ENTERPRISE ZONE PROCESSING FEE BY \$10 TO \$40**

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland periodically updates its Master Fee Schedule to account for general cost of living increases and program changes or other costs; and

WHEREAS, the fee modifications and additions proposed herein have been justified by the Community and Economic Development Agency and are identified in the Agenda Report accompanying this Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the herein-referenced modifications and additions are necessary to reimburse the State of California Housing and Community Development for the costs of administering the State Enterprise Zone Program;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the City of Oakland does hereby ordain as follows:

**Section 1.** The Master Fee Schedule as set forth in Ordinance No. 12611 C.M.S. is hereby amended to increase the \$30 Enterprise Zone tax credit voucher processing fee assessed by the Community and Economic Development Agency by \$10 to \$40.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage as provided by Section 216 of the City Charter, if adopted by at least six members of Council, or upon the seventh day after final adoption if adopted by fewer votes.
