## RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF OAKLAND TO CLAIM, ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE FY 2003-04 STATE TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT ARTICLE 3 FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$637,266 FOR HIGH-PRIORITY PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE PROJECTS

WHEREAS, Article 3 of the Transportation Development Act (TDA), Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section 99200 et seq., authorizes the submission of claims to a regional transportation planning agency for the funding of projects exclusively for the benefit and/or use of pedestrians and bicyclists; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC), as the regional transportation planning agency for the San Francisco Bay region, has adopted MTC Resolution No. 875, Revised, entitled "Transportation Development Act, Article 3, Pedestrian/Bicycle Projects," which delineates procedures and criteria for submission of requests for the allocation of "TDA Article 3" funding; and

WHEREAS, MTC Resolution No. 875, Revised requires that requests for the allocation of TDA Article 3 funding \$637,266 be submitted as part of a single, countywide coordinated claim from each county in the San Francisco Bay region; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland desires to apply for \$295,266 in FY2003-2004 TDA Article 3 funds for the construction of 614 curb ramps and other sidewalk improvements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland also desires to apply for \$116,000 in FY2003-2004 TDA Article 3 funds for the construction of pedestrian and bicycle improvements on the Lake Merritt 12<sup>th</sup> Street Dam roadway; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland also desires to apply for \$100,000 in FY2003-2004 TDA Article 3 funds for the construction of pedestrian bulb-outs at Highland Elementary and Fremont High School; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland also desires to rescind and reallocate a \$96,000 FY 00-01 TDA Article 3 allocation for the construction of bicycle lanes on Bancroft Avenue from 96<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Durant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland further desires, on behalf of Alameda County and the cities of Alameda County, to apply for \$30,000 in FY 2003-2004 TDA Article 3 funds for the 2003 Walk/Bike California conference -- an educational project for the exclusive benefit and/or use of pedestrians and/or bicyclists; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**: That the City of Oakland declares it is eligible to request an allocation of TDA Article 3 funds pursuant to Section 99234 of the Public Utilities Code; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That a certified copy of this resolution and its attachments, and any accompanying supporting materials shall be forwarded to the Alameda County Congestion Management Agency for submission to MTC as part of the countywide coordinated TDA Article 3 claim; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Council authorizes the application, acceptance and appropriation of FY 2003-2004 TDA Article 3 allocation of \$295,266 for the construction of 614 curb ramps citywide and other sidewalk improvements; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Council authorizes the application, acceptance and appropriation of FY 2003-2004 TDA Article 3 allocation of \$116,000 for the construction of bicycle and pedestrian improvements at the 12<sup>th</sup> Street Dam; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Council authorizes the application, acceptance and appropriation of FY 2003-2004TDA Article 3 allocation of \$100,000 for the construction of pedestrian bulb-outs at Highland Elementary and Fremont High School; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Council authorizes the rescission, and reallocation of a \$96,000 FY 00-01 allocation for the Bancroft Avenue Bike Lanes, as well as the acceptance and appropriation of these reallocated funds for the construction of bicycle lanes on Bancroft Avenue from 96<sup>th</sup> Avenue to Durant; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Council authorizes, on behalf of Alameda County and the cities of Alameda County, the application, acceptance and appropriation of FY 2003-2004 TDA Article 3 allocation of \$30,000 to underwrite the first Statewide Conference on Walking and Bicycling, to be held in downtown Oakland; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized, on behalf of the City of Oakland, to execute and submit all documents, payment requests and related actions, as well as to appropriate any additional grant funds received for the completion of the aforementioned projects; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED**: That should additional funds be received for the above listed projects, the City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept and appropriate the same for the purposes described above.
